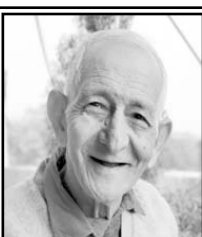

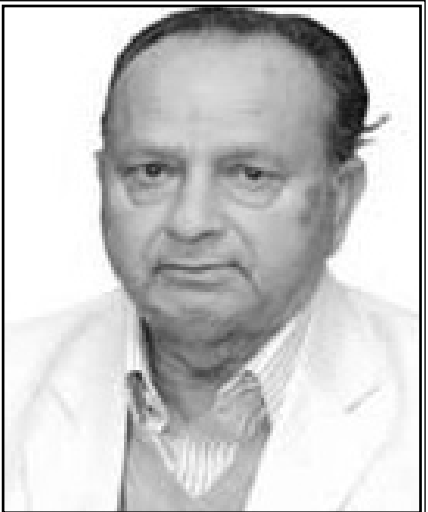

## CRIME REPORT

### Bootlegger nabbed, 25 bottles of illicit liquor recovered

NAGROTA: Police on Friday nabbed a bootlegger and recovered 25 bottles of illicit liquor from his possession.

As per details, a team of Police Station Nagrota under the supervision of SDPO Nagrota Pardeep Kumar led by SHO Nagrota Inspr Vishav Partap Singh assisted by PSI Mohd Zahid while on Naka duty at Khanpur Nagrota, rounded up a suspect namely Bishan Singh, son of Bidaya Singh, resident of Khanpur Nagrota. During search, 25 bottles of illicit liquor and Rs 660 cash was recovered from his possession. He was arrested and FIR No. 324 under section 48 (f) was registered against him at Police Station Nagrota.

### 6 vehicles seized for illegal mining

JAMMU/SRINAGAR: In a quest to stern menace of illegal mining, a multi-pronged strategy was devised by Jammu Police in which police teams of Police Station Kana Chak acted stringently on specific inputs and raided at different locations in their respective areas and seized 3 vehicles involved in illegal mining, including two tippers and a tractor-trolley without registration numbers. DMO Jammu was also intimidated about the same. The recoveries were made by SHO Kanaachak Inspr Rahul Mahajan under the jurisdiction of Police Station Kana Chak.

Acting tough against elements involved in illegal extraction and transportation of minerals, Police in Budgam arrested 3 persons and seized 3 vehicles involved in crime.

As per details, a party of Police Post Humhama at a checkpoint established at Laloo Sheshgari intercepted three tippers loaded with illegally extracted soil. The vehicles bearing registration numbers JK01M-2211, JK05B-0747 and JK04B-7700 were seized and drivers identified as Basharat Ali Ganai, son of Mohammad Baqir Ganai, resident of Bodina Budgam; Javaid Ahmad Ganai, son of Ghulam Mohammad Ganai, resident of Bodina Budgam and Sarfaraz Akhter Chopan, son of Zahoor Ahmad Chopan, resident of Mahawar Budgam were arrested. They were shifted to police station where they remained in custody. Accordingly, a case under relevant sections of law has been registered in Police Station Budgam and investigation started.

### Man drowns in canal

JAMMU: A man died due to drowning in Ranbir Canal at Muthi.

The body of deceased was later fished out and shifted to mortuary of GMC&H Jammu for completion of medical and legal formalities. The deceased was identified as Rashpal Singh, resident of Akalpur, District Jammu. Domana Police has taken cognizance in this regard.

### Abducted minor girl recovered within 24 hours, accused arrested

BUDGAM: Police on Friday recovered an abducted minor girl within 24 hours and arrested accused person involved in crime.

As per details, on September 1, 2022 evening, Police Post Soibugh received a complaint from a resident of Khan Mohalla Soibugh stating therein that his minor daughter did not return home after school while school administration stated that she didn't attend the school. Accordingly, FIR No. 306/2022 under relevant sections of law was registered at Police Station Budgam and investigation started. Subsequently, a special Police team under the supervision of Incharge Police Post Soibugh was constituted to trace out missing girl. During the course of investigation, the Police team, acting swiftly, raided various suspected locations and after strenuous efforts, learnt that missing girl was abducted by one Salib Ahmad Hella, son of Assadullah Hella, resident of Khuri Batapora Kulgam. The Police party raided a specific location and recovered abducted girl. The abductor was also arrested within 24 hours after complaint was lodged. After fulfilling all legal formalities, the girl was handed over to her legal heirs. Further investigation is going on.

### 14 injured in Sumo accident

POONCH: At least 13 passengers got injured when a Tata Magic Sumo met with an accident at Degwar area of Tehsil Haveli in Poonch district on Friday Morning.

As per details, a Tata Magic bearing registration no (JK12 5772) coming from Poonch towards Degwar, when reached crusher area of Tehsil Haveli, the driver lost control over vehicle due to which it fell into a gorge and 14 person got injured. Soon after accident, locals and Police rushed to the spot and shifted injured to DH Poonch for treatment. The injured were identified as Raj Kumar, Renu Sharma, Rasham Bi, Sabar Miya, Ram Pal, Zaheen Akhter, Shaheen Akhter, Mohd Haneef, Taj Mohd, Mohd Rafiq, Tarlochan Singh, Mansoor Miya and Parmot Sharma. FIR No 190/2022 under section 279/337 of IPC was registered in Police Station Poonch.



### 2,484 MT illegally excavated sand seized in Billawar

KATHUA: A team of Geology and Mining department and police officials, on Friday, seized dumps of 2484 MT sand illegally excavated from Ujh river during several raids conducted in different places in Billawar area. As many as 13 dumps of sand were stocked at Pongat, Leir, Guda Kalyal, Thada Kalyal, Peiya and Dharmani areas of Billawar were seized under relevant sections of SRO-105 of 2016 and MM&DR Act of 1957 and kept in the custody of police till further action. The sand dumps were excavated from Ujh river in Tehsil Ramkot by the miners by using light machinery and transported on tractor trolleys for further sale at exorbitant and willful rates in violation of rules and norms of the department. "As per rules, no person can excavate or dump minor or crushed mineral beyond personal use and for legal dumping, Mineral Dealer License (MDL) is required from the Geology and Mining department after following a due procedure in vogue and submitting requisite documents along with application," informed DMO Kathua

During day-long exercise, awareness was also spread among the local people about the prevalent rules for excavation, transportation and dumping of minor and crushed minerals and rates of minerals along with legally demarcated and identified locations for purchase of material. It is pertinent to mention here that a total of 9 minor mineral blocks have been e-auctioned and allotted to contractors in Bhini and

Naj Nallahs from where minerals can be purchased by consumers on government fixed rates for further transportation on recently introduced e-challans. Earlier last month, 1200 MTs of illegally dumped sand was seized by the Geology & Mining Department in Kumri Kathera areas.

### 1,250 MT sand seized, 3,000 MT sand restored in Bajalta area

JAMMU: Geology and Mining Department teams on Friday raided different locations at Sidhra, Chalni, Sardhan and Anthem areas, early in morning and seized 1,250 MT illegally stocked/dumped sand.

On directions of Deputy Commissioner Jammu Avny Lavasa, District Mineral Officer, Dr Gulshan Kumar along with staff members and Chowki Officer Sidra conducted the raids in wee hours. The DMO informed that the office of Deputy Commissioner Jammu and DMO office received complaints regarding illegal stocking of minor minerals in area. "Acting against violators, the operation was conducted and 250 MT of sand was seized while 1000 MT was restored to Chelni Nallah with help of JCB," he added.

In another raid, DMO Jammu along with a team of Geology and Mining and police, visited Sardan and Athem area and seized 1000 MT sand and restored 2000 MT sand in nearby Nallah with help of an excavator. The custody of 1250 MT seized material was handed over to Chowki officer Sidhra and general public was advised not to lift the same otherwise strict action shall be taken against violators.

The DMO also advised the general public and transporters to transport the minor minerals with valid challan/Form A. He further said that drive against illegal mining will continue in future.
