UDHAMPUR: District Police Udhampur held a youth awareness campaign at Nursing Dev Institute of Medical Science Udhampur and delivered informative and motivating lecture among the participants regarding the ill effects of narcotic drug addiction, traffic rules and many other important things.

The event was organized on the directions of SSP Udhampur Dr. Vinod Kumar. PSI Pallvi Rajput chaired the event along with Devika Sharma (Drug Counsellor), Afia Nazir and Azra Khan Social Worker of Women Right Project at Special Cell Women Police Station Udhampur.

PSI Pallvi Rajput interacted with the participants and delivered informative/motivating views and spread awareness about the prevailing criminal activities, new traffic rules, wear helmets while riding, and further appealed to the participants to remain alert and project themselves from falling prey in the hands of criminals.

Devika Sharma on the occasion, said that the issue of drug abuse is a challenge before the country. It is the duty of all stakeholders to join in creating awareness about the illegal use of drugs and the measures to be taken to prevent this menace. She also highlighted their experience in treating drug addicts. They gave a detailed speech on how to recognize that a person is addicted of drugs, treatment and testing process.

While speaking Afia Nazir and Azra Khan Social Worker of women right project at special cell Women Police Station Udhampur also addressed

Sheep Units shall be provided to the beneficiary free of Cost and from 3rd year of establishment, department shall retrieve 2 animals from each breeder for next five year. The progeny to be retrieved should be 1.5 to 2 years age with minimum body weight of 25-30 Kgs. One livestock unit details as under:-
