Journey of a teacher must be from ordinary to extraordinary: Prof Aima

JAMMU: You may enter the teaching world as an ordinary teacher but you must not exit it as an ordinary teacher. This journey from an ordinary teacher to an extraordinary one is what makes the difference, said Prof. Ashok Aima while speaking on "How to be a good teacher" during a programme at the Northern Regional Centre of the Indian Institute of Mass Communication (IIMC) in Jammu on Monday. "This," he added, "does not require a divine intervention; it's we the teachers who have to make that happen." Former Central University of Jammu Vice Chancellor Prof. Aima and renowned mathematician Prof. Veda Nand Jha were the guests in the programme organised on the occasion of teachers' day. Prof. Jha, who headed the mathematics department at Marwari College of Tilka Manjhi Bhagalpur University at Bhagalpur, enumerated some attributes of a good teacher. He said, "A teacher must be honest, devoted to his/her duty, content, punctual, thankful to God, lifelong learner and healthy." Remembering his deliberations during the formation of the New Education Policy, Prof. Aima stressed the need for transforming classrooms to the knowledge institutions. He said that knowledge creation should happen in the classroom, not in the textbooks. Prof. Rakesh Kumar Goswami, Regional Director, IIMC, Jammu welcomed the guests. English Journalism course coordinator Dumar conducted the proceedings. Prof. Anil Saumitra spoke about the challenges before teachers to remain relevant beyond classrooms.
