

CRIME REPORT

Narco smuggler nabbed with heroin

BISHNAH: Continuing its drive against drug trafficking and substance abuse, Police on Tuesday nabbed a narco smuggler and recovered 8 grams of heroin from his possession.

As per the details, a team of Police Station Bishnah led by SHO Police Station Bishnah Inspector Vikram Sharma while on Naka duty at Chorley Kothey Bishnah rounded up one suspect who was on his way Lalyana towards Bishnah on a vehicle (JK02BM- 4022). On search 08 grams of heroin was recovered from him. The suspect identified as Bharat Bhushan, son of Subash Chander; resident of Dyanasar, Tehsil Bari- Bhramana Distt Samba was arrested and FIR No. 152/2022 under sections 8/21/22 NDPS Act was registered against him in Police Station Bishnah and. The whole operation was done under the supervision of SDPO RS Pura Surinder Singh.



5 vehicles involved in illegal mining seized

JAMMU: In a quest to stern the menace of illegal mining, a multi-pronged strategy was devised by Jammu Police in which police team of Police Stations Pacea Danga, Jhajjar Kotli, Gharota, Domana and Police Post Jourian acted stringently on the specific inputs and raided at different locations in their respective areas and seized 5 vehicles involved in illegal mining. The seized vehicles include one Tipper (JK11A-3851) seized by Jhajjar Kotli Police; one vehicle (JK02CS-3771) by Pacea Danga Police; One tractor without registration No by Gharota Police; one tractor trolley without Registration no by Domana Police and one tractor without registration No by Jourian Police.

DMO Jammu was also intimated about the same.

The recoveries were made by SHO Jhajjar Kotli Inspr Samson Bhatti, SHO Pacea Danga Inspr Rakesh Sharma, SHO Gharota Inspr Rajesh Khajuria, SHO Domana Inspr Tlak Raj and In-Charge Police Post Jourian PSI Karnail Singh in their respective jurisdictions.

Seven liquor smuggling bids foiled; 8 arrested

REASI/SAMBA: As a part of Nasha Mukht Bharat Abiyaan launched by Central Government and intensifying the drive against drug abuse and illicit liquor smug-

gling teams of District Police Reasi under the supervision of Dysp Headquarters Iftkhar Ahmed foiled six illicit liquor smuggling bids in Reasi and Pouni area and arrested seven notorious smugglers in last 24 hours.

Team of Police Post Bhambla led by PSI Hiteshwar Singh laid a surprise naka near GREF Camp at Bhambla area, intercepted one illicit liquor smuggler namely Kuldeep Raj, son of Om Parkash, resident of Thed Tehsil Pouni District Reasi, during frisking 02 litres (desi) Illicit liquor got recovered from his possession. On this case FIR no 53/2022 under sections 48 (a) Excise Act stands registered at Police Station Pouni and investigation started.

In another incident Police team of Police Post Jyotipuram led by PSI Rajat Sahani laid a surprise Naka near Jyotipuram area. Police party apprehended one notorious illicit liquor Smuggler namely Chankar Singh, son of Tirath Ram, resident of Sawalakote Tehsil Arnas District Reasi, during checking 12 Beer Can & 05 bottles of Desi Whisky got recovered from his possession. FIR No. 220/2022 under sections 48 (a) Excise Act registered at Police Station Reasi and investigation initiated.

Team of Police team of Police Station Reasi led by Insp. Purab Singh laid a surprise naka near Trintha area of Reasi. On seeing the Police party two person namely Kher Singh, son of Bagh Singh, residnet of Sawlakote and Bittu Ram, son of Suram Chand, resident of Khanikote Tehsil Arnas District Reasi tried to evade the naka in vehicle swift (JK20B-6635). Police chased and intercepted the vehicle, during checking and frisking 21 bottles of JK Desi Whisky of 750 ml each recovered from their possession. On this a case FIR No. 221/2022 U/S 48 (f) Excise Act registered at Police Station Reasi and investigation started.

In another incident a team of Police Post Tote Sarhi led by ASI Baldeep Singh apprehended one person namely Dharam Chand, son of Soba Ram, resident of Choura kote Tehsil Bhomag District Reasi and recovered 4.5 litres (desi) Illicit liquor from his possession. On this a case FIR No. 222/2022 under sections 48 (a) Excise Act registered at P/S Reasi and investigation started.

In Dera Baba area team of Police Post Dera led by PSI Jarnail Singh on a specific information apprehended one person namely Avtar Singh, son of Daler Singh, resident of Tanda, and recovered 2 ltrs of illicit (desi) liquor from his possession. FIR no 223 under sections 48 (A) Excise Act registered at Police Station Reasi and investigations initiated.

Team of Police Post Bhambla apprehended one person namely Mohan Lal, son of Thodu Ram, resident of Dadoo Tehsil Pouni, and recovered 1.5 ltrs. of illicit (Desi) liquor was recovered from his possession. FIR no 54 under sections 48 (A),Excise Act was registered at Police Station Pouni and investigation initiated.

Amit Gupta Senior Superintendent of Police Reasi while sharing the details conveyed that Reasi Police is committed to eradicate the menace of drug abuse and illicit liquor smuggling from the area which is must to save the future generations.

In noather action, acting on a reliable information about distillation of Desi illicit liquor at village Radwan, a party of Police Station Rangmarh headed by SHO Rangarh rushed to the spot and caught a person red handed manufacturing desi liquor illegally at his home.

The accused person identified as Joginder Pal, son of Kewal Kumar, resident of Radwan, Rangarh was arrested on the spot.

Further on the disclosure of said accused person, about 50 ltrs of Lahan stored in plastic drum buried under the field was recovered and destroyed.

Moreover 15 litres of desi illicit liquor stored in plastic gallan was also seized on spot along with the stills, utensils which were being used for the manufacture of illegal Desi liquor. FIR No. 78/2022 U/S 48 (e) Excise Act stands registered at PS Rangarh and investigation taken up.

Army jawan booked under rape charges

Bishnah shoot-out: 3 arrested; arms, 2 cars recovered, 2 absconding

BISHNAH: Police on Tuesday arrested three accused in the firing case on Ring Road of Bishnah. Two sharp weapons and two cars have been recovered from their possession. However raids are being conducted to arrest two accused which are absconding. According to the information, there was an incident of firing on the Ring Road of Bishnah on Saturday in which a youth namely Mansha, son of Mohammad Mirza, resident Batidia Akhnoor was seriously injured and was referred to Amritsar for treatment. The incident had created panic in the area, because many rounds were fired on the spot. The police went to Amritsar on Monday and took the statements of the injured after which the police identified the accused. After that Bishnah police led by SHO Bishnah Inspector Vikram Sharma along with Vijaypur police arrested the three accused which have been identified as Sunil Sharma alias Kadu, son of Babu Ram, resident of Gagore Vijaypur; Sahil Chowdhary alias Shalhu, son of Vijay Kumar, resident of Rangoor Camp Rangarh and Rohit Billowria, son of Gopal Krishan, resident of Vijaypur . Two accused in this case are still absconding and have been identified as Akshay and Makhan. Police are continuously conducting raids to arrest them. During the investigation it was found that the assailants also snatched the car of the injured during the incident which has been recovered whereas the car was used by the other party in the incident has been seized too.
