## JKSAC highlights demands of DPs of 1947

RAJOURI: In continuation of reach-out campaign started by Jammu Kashmir Sharnarthi Action Committee (JKSAC) to aware the DPs of 1947 from POK about the basic issues concerning their final settlement, a team comprising of Gurdev Singh -President, Bagwan Singh, Capt. Puran Singh Chib & Joginder Lal took a three days extensive tour of all the DP villages situated in various tehsils of district Rajouri. In this regard meetings were held at village Dhangri, Muradpur, Bathouni, Doongi (Tehsil Rajouri), Dabbar, Kalal, Deeing, Siyal, Lambheri (Tehsil

Nowshera), Brehvi, Dubbian (Tehsil Kakote), Sunderbani proper & Bajabain. Large number of DPs all over the villages participated in the meetings.

While interacting with the participants Gurdev Singh and his visiting team apprised the DPs about their issues and told them that a protracted struggle was launched by JKSAC since its inception in 1967 for the permanent resolution of the basic issues viz-a-viz, firstly adequate compensation of their left-out properties in POK, secondly resolution for their wards in govt. services / technical institutions, thirdly defreezing of their share of

assembly seats and fourthly, full proprietary rights over the allotted lands.

He said that with the creation of J&K as a UT, DPs were very hopeful that adequate measures would be taken to resolve their decade old legitimate issues as J&K is now fully and constitutionally integrated with India and is now directly under the control of Union govt. and added that it is the most appropriate time for the central govt. to set right the wrongs committed by the earlier govt. The DPs have been denied of their rights all along these years which resulted in their economical, educational and social backwardness. He

reiterated that the DPs are thankful to the PM Narendra Modi for providing a package of Rs 5.5 lakhs which gave reorganization to their issues and provided them some financial relief. He also deputed a Joint Parliamentary Committee (JPC) to go into the demands of DPs - 1947 which studied their case and recommended Rs 30 lakh for final settlement but there was no further action has so far been taken on these recommendations.

He told the DPs that govt. has been reminded many times before and afterwards that this little package cannot be considered as one time full and final settlement as claimed by some govt. bureo

crats. He told the DPs that govt. has been asked many times to spell out the criteria adopted to arrive at this amount without taking into consideration the huge loss of life and properties suffered by DPs families.

The DPs in all over these meetings made humble appeal to PM Narendra Modi to issue advisory to the Lt. Governor Manoj K. Sinha for the preparation of road-map as per the JPC report 183 for the settlement of DPs till POK is liberated and the loss of their properties in POK is assessed.

## Kootah residents protest for repair of road
