Taxpayers liable to pay Advance Tax

- Any assessee, including salaried employee, whose tax liability for the financial year as reduced by the tax deducted / collected at source is ₹10,000/- or more.
- Resident Senior Citizen not having income from business/ profession is not liable to pay.

Mode of Payment

- e-payment is mandatory for all Corporates and also those assessee whose accounts are required to be audited u/s 44 AB of the Income-tax Act, 1961.
- e-payment is convenient for other taxpayers also as it ensures correct credit.

Schedule for payment of Advance Tax

Due Date	Amount
(a) On or before 15 th of June, 2022	15% of the Advance Tax payable.
(b) On or before 15 th of September, 2022	45% of the Advance Tax payable.
(c) On or before 15 th of December, 2022	75% of the Advance Tax payable.
(d) On or before 15 th of March, 2023	100% of the Advance Tax payable.

Short / Non-payment or deferment of payment of Advance Tax will result in levy of interest
