# CRIMEREPORT

## 5 vehicles involved in illegal mining seized

**STATE TIMES NEWS**

JAMMU: In a quest to stem the menace of illegal mining, a multi-pronged strategy was devised by Jammu Police in which police teams of Police Stations Bishnah, Akhnoor, Police Post Phallain Mandal, Belicharna and Chinore acted stringently on the specific inputs and raided at a location in their respective area and seized 5 vehicles involved in illegal mining.

The seized vehicles include 2 vehicles i.e Two tractors bearing Registration No. JK02BF 1349 and Chasis No BZZDE100827852, by Bishnah police; One Tractor trolley bearing registration no JK02CS 8851, by Akhnoor police; One tractor trolley without Registration No. by Phallain Mandal police and One tractor trolley bearing Registration No JK02DC 3858, by Belicharna Police.

The recoveries were made by SHO Bishnah Insp. Vikram Sharma, SHO Akhnoor Insp. Zaheer Mushtaq, In-Charge Police Post Phallain Mandal PSI Ajesh Singh Jamwal, In-Charge Police Post Belicharna SI Sugreev Kumar in their respective jurisdictions.

## 4 narco smugglers nabbed with heroin

JAMMU: Continuing its drive against drug trafficking and substance abuse, Police nabbed 4 narco smugglers and recovered 10 grams of heroin.

As per details, a team of Police Station Nagrota led by SDPO Nagrota Akash Kohli assisted by SHO Nagrota Insp. Vishav Partap Singh and PSI Amreek Singh while on Naka duty TCP Nagrota rounded up three suspected persons who were coming on a vehicle Bolero bearing Registratinn No. JK20 7800 from Jammu towards Udhampur.

During search 05 grams of heroin was recovered from the possession of accused later identified as Manjeet Singh, son of Mohan Singh, resident of Sool SMVDU Katra Reasi; Raghuraj Singh, son of Persid Singh, resident of Sool Katra Reasi and Amzad Hussain, son of Gulsher resident of Chack Bhagtha SMVDU Katra Reasi. They were arrested and FIR No. 365/2023 under section 8/21/22/29 NDPS Act was registered at Police Station Nagrota.

Poonch Police also arrested one narcotic smuggler namely Shakeel Ahmad, son of Mohd Akram, resident of Gagrian and recovered 5 grams of heroine like substance from him at Special night Naka at Lassana.

FIR no. 287/2023 U/S 8/21/22 NDPS ACT has been registered at Police Station Surankote.

## Two missing girls traced, reunited with families

JAMMU: Police on Saturday traced two missing girls and reunited them with their families.

As per details, a written complaint was lodged at Police Post Gadigarh by father of two girls stating that they got missing from their home. In this regard missing report was registered and investigation started. After this, a team of Police Post Gadigarh led by SDPO South Sachit Sharma assisted by SHO Satwari Insp. Sumeet Sharma and In-Charge Police Post Gadigarh SI now Insp. Ravinder Singh did strenuous efforts and finally traced both the missing girls.

Subsequently families of both the missing girls were informed and traced girls were handed over to their family members after completing all the legal formalities.

## Two theft cases solved, two arrested

JAMMU: Police on Saturday solved two theft cases and arrested two accused.

As per details, a complaint was lodged at Police Station Janipur from Majeed Hussain, son of Bagh Ali, resident of Paloura Jammu stating that some unknown thief has stolen goats from his house. On this complaint FIR

No.92/2023 under sections 380 IPC was registered and investigation started.

On this, a team of Police Station Janipur led by SDPO West Vikram Singh assisted by SHO Janipur Insp. Sikander Singh did strenuous efforts and with the help of CCTV footages of the area finally recovered the stolen goats from the possession of accused person namely Bunty Sharma, son of Bishan Dass, resident of Jandyal Thatli, Aghore Jammu.

Similarly another complaint was received at Police Station Janipur from another complainant namely Bilal Ashraf Shah, resident of Gujjar Mohalla Paloura regarding theft of his Swift car (JK17- 3357). Accused was arrested and FIR No. 89/2013 under section 379 IPC was registered at Police Station Janipur. After this, a team of Police Station Janipur led by SDPO West Vikram Singh assisted by SHO Janipur Insp. Sikander Singh did strenuous efforts and with the help of CCTV footages of the areas finally rounded up the suspected person namely Ghulam Nabi, son of Abdul Rashid, resident of Gool District Ramban. During questioning accused confessed his involvement in the above case and on his disclosure stolen vehicle was recovered from his possession.

## Two bootleggers nabbed, 46 bottles of illicit liquor recovered

AKHNOOR: Police on Saturday nabbed two bootleggers and recovered 46 bottles of illicit liquor from their possession.

As per details, an information was received at Police Station Akhnoor regarding two persons selling illicit liquor in the area.

After this, a team of Police Station Akhnoor led by SDPO Akhnoor Mohan Sharma assisted by SHO Akhnoor Insp. Zaheer Mushtaq established a naka at Lehar, Sungal near Ashram and rounded up two suspected persons who were on their way from Akhnoor towards Sungal on their Scooty (JK02AX-3724). During search, 46 bottles of illicit liquor i.e 42 Quarters of 180 ML and 04 Quarters of 750 ML got recovered from their possession.

The accused identified as Baldev Raj, son of Lajju Ram, resident of Patan Mandrian and Balbir Kumar, son of Kewal Krishan, resident of Patan Mandrian were arrested and FIR No. 253/2023 under sections 48-A, 48-F Act has been registered at PS Akhnoor and accused got arrested.

## Woman nabbed 2.5 Kgs Ganja

JAMMU: Continuing its drive against drug trafficking and substance abuse, Police on Saturday nabbed a woman and recovered 2 Kgs 500 grams of Ganja from her possession.

As per details, a team of Police Post Narwal led by SDPO East Syed Zaheer Abbas Jafari assisted by SHO Bahu Fort Insp. Shiv Dev Singh and In-Charge Police Post Narwal SI Lalit Sharma while on patrolling duty at Rajiv Nagar area rounded up a suspected person coming from coming from Narwal towards Mohalla Rajiv nagar.

During search 2 Kgs 500 grams of ganja was recovered from the possession of accused later identified as Rubi, daughter of Ab Rashid, resident of Rajiv Nagar. She was arrested and FIR No. 269/23 under section 8/20 NDPS Act was registered at Police Station Bahu Fort Jammu.

## Drug peddler arrested; psychotropic substance recovered

SRINAGAR: Continuing its efforts to eradicate the menace of drugs from the society, Police in Bandipora have arrested a drug peddler and recovered psychotropic substance from his possession.

A Police party of PS Sumbal at a checkpoint established at Trigam Sumbal Crossing, intercepted a vehicle (Creta car) bearing registration Number JK01AU-9800 driven by Amir Rashid Sheikh son of Ab Rashid sheikh resident of Shilvat Sumbal. During search, 33 bottles of Codeine Phosphate bottles and cash amount of ₹15,000 (proceeds of narcotic crime) were recovered from his possession. He has been arrested and the vehicle used in the commission of crime has also been seized.

Accordingly, a case under relevant sections of law has been registered at PS Sumbal and investigation has been initiated.

## Accused involved in kidnapping & rape arrested

## LCMA continues demolition drive against illegal constructions

SRINAGAR: In order to curb the menace of illegal constructions, the Lake Conservation & Management Authority through its Enforcement Wing on Saturday under the supervision of Enforcement Officer the department undertook a special demolition drive in the area of WFR in which several illegal constructions were demolished / removed.

These includes 02 tin walls, 01 Ten shed, 01 Wooden 3rd storey & 01 Single storey. Also illegal earth filling was also removed in the Babe-demb area which was dumped by some unknown persons.

Besides, legal action has also been initiated against the violators. The Special demolition drives will be continued within LCMA Jurisdiction especially in Green Belt (200 mts) and the violators will be dealt under law.

Therefore, people within LCMA Jurisdiction are time and again warned not to resort to any kind of illegal construction / encroachments within LCMA Jurisdiction especially Green Belt (200 mts).

Moreso, people residing within the LCMA residential area are requested to get proper building permission from the competent authority before taking any construction work in hand, otherwise, strict action shall be taken against them.

SLA announces Rs 10 lakh reward for information on advocate's killers Srinagar: The Jammu and Kashmir State Investigation Agency on Saturday announced a cash reward of Rs 10 lakh for information about the killers of Babar Qadri, an advocate shot dead by militants in 2020.

The State Investigation Agency (SLA) said in a public notice, "A cash reward of Rs 10,00,000 (Rs 10 lakh) is announced for those providing information leading to the arrest of the persons involved in the killing of senior advocate of Jammu and Kashmir High Court Babar Qadri who was killed by terrorists on 24.09.2020 at his residence." The agency said the identity of the informer will be kept highly confidential. "Those having any information can contact us at the mobile/WhatsApp/Telegram/Signal number 9103998467 and email satsiabq62@gmail.com," it said.

Qadri was shot dead by militants in his residence in the Hawal area here. The police had earlier said Saqib Manzoor, the deputy commander of The Resistance Front, was involved in Qadri's killing. Manzoor was killed in an encounter in the city in August 2021 along with Abbas Sheikh, the outfit's chief commander.

## BSF jawan reported missing near LoC in Poonch


MENDHAR: A BSF jawan was reported missing from his post near the Line of Control in Poonch district, officials said on Saturday.


