
# SHRADHANJALI



# Nearly 15 Lakh people participated in 'Brashtachar Mukht J&K Week' campaign

**SRINAGAR:** On the conclusion of the 'Brashtachar Mukht J&K Week' held between 4-9th September in the UT, Chief Secretary, Dr Arun Kumar Mehta reiterated that the fight against corruption is not a one-off event but a continuous process that needs to become integral part of our thinking and action. He stated that the UT Administration does not believe in just symbolism but is committed to take this fight against the corruption to each and every household. He observed that the corrupt practices are beneficial to only few individuals who amass illegitimate wealth but detrimental for the welfare of general public.

He said that the society as a whole can progress only by defeating corruption in all its dimensions and forms. He emphasized that the task has to be

accomplished collectively by working hand in hand with the administration. The Anti-Corruption bodies like ACB and Crime Branch have to play their due role. He highlighted that it is for these reasons that the theme of the upcoming Vigilance Week has been kept as 'corruption free society for development of the nation'.

Referring to the recently concluded 'Digital Week', the Chief Secretary emphasized that the digital empowerment of public is contributing hugely to reducing corruption in the system. He said that the IT enabled features like e-tendering, BEAMS, Janbhagadari, geo-tagging, digital payments and physical verification have saved the government exchequer from being siphoned off by the vested interests to a large extent.

He encouraged people to make it

their habit to apply for services online from their homes without visiting offices physically. He disclosed that there are around 1020 services onboarded on eUnnat portal and some 900 services on 'Mobile Dost' application. He said that it is easy for everyone to apply for any citizen-centric service themselves just using their mobile phone devices.

He announced that soon the administration is going to roll out the 'Digi Dost' scheme under which an IT person will visit homes of applicants with their devices and assist them in making requisite applications online on the nominal fee.

Dr Mehta added that J&K has truly undergone the 'digital transformation' in the last couple of years. He asserted that it has reduced the gap between the far-flung areas and urban centers

of the UT. He elucidated that it is for the first time that any Chief Secretary has virtually visited more than 50 remote panchayats and listened to the grievances of people directly.

He further went on to say that digital J&K is part of preparation for the future-ready J&K. He said that J&K is well on track to steer its way ahead for making the necessary progress and become a role-model for others.

He also said that J&K is going to have single database for the whole UT which would greatly enhance the efficiency and availability of services to its citizens. He recalled that the auto-appeal feature of the online services is revolutionizing the service delivery as per the timelines set under the Public Services Guarantee Act (PSGA). He stated that more than 22000 cases had been auto-escalated and 800 officials

had been fined for violating the time-lines stipulated under the act.

Dr Mehta pointed out that while there is need to bring every complaint by the citizens to its logical conclusion, it is equally important to protect the well-meaning officers who had acted in good faith with honesty and integrity. He remarked that any motivated and malafide complaint needs to be thoroughly investigated and the complainants taken to task as per law.

He called upon the Incharge Secretaries of each district to ensure that there is free discussion about 'Brashtachar' in their districts. He directed the 'Prabhari Officers' to make mention of the same in monthly panchayat convergence meetings in presence of people and Panchayat members so that the fight against corruption reaches the grassroots level.

# CRIMEREPORT

## 11 vehicles seized, 11 persons arrested for illegal mining

**BARAMULLA:** Acting tough against the persons involved in illegal extraction and transportation of minerals, police have seized 11 vehicles and arrested 11 persons in Baramulla. A police party under the supervision of DySP Hqrs Baramulla assisted by SHO PS Baramulla & IC PP Delina seized 08 vehicles (8 tippers) and arrested 8 drivers for their involvement in illegal extraction and transportation of minerals at Khanpora & Delina. They have been identified as Javid Ahmad Dar son of Mohd Ramzan Dar resident of Jalsheeri, Gh Mohi-ud-Din Khan son of Mohd Akbar Khan resident of, Mohd Yousuf Sheikh son Mohd Abdullah resident of Kitehama, Irshad Ahmad Khan son of Ab Gani resident of Khanpora, Gh Qadir Bhat son of Ab Rehman resident of Beerwah Budgam, Shahnaz Ahmad Mir son of Gh Ahmad resident of Kalampora, Mashooq Ahmad Dar son of Bashir Ahmad resident of Kungamdara Pattan & Manzoor Ahmad Bhat son of Gh Mohd resident of Kachu Muqam Chandoosa. Similarly, a police party under the supervision of SDPO Tangmarg assisted by SHO PS Kunzer seized 1 vehicle (1 tipper) and arrested 1 driver; involved in illegal extraction and transportation of minerals at Bongam Kunzer. He has been identified as Rouf Ahmad Lone son of Gh Rasool resident of Gokhama Kunzer. In addition, a police party under the supervision of SDPO Pattan assisted by IC PP Kungamdara seized 2 vehicles (2 tractors) and arrested 2 drivers for their involvement in illegal extraction and transportation of minerals at Khoresherabad. They have been identified as Subail Ahmad Ganie son of Gh Mohd resident of Khoresherabad & Aarif Dilawar Rather son of Mohd Dilawar resident of Lalpora Kunzer. Accordingly, cases under relevant sections of law have been registered at respective Police Stations and investigation have been initiated.

## Police arrests 2 drug peddlers; contraband substance recovered

**BARAMULLA:** Continuing its efforts to eradicate the menace of drugs from the society, Police have arrested 2 drug peddlers in Baramulla and recovered contraband

substance from his possession.

They have been arrested and shifted to police station where they remain in custody.

## 200 bottles of illicit liquor recovered, bootlegger arrested

**JAMMU:** On the basis of the information received at PS Akhnoor regarding the sale of illicit liquor in the area, a significant operation was conducted, resulting in the recovery of 200 bottles of illicit liquor and the arrest of one bootlegger.

The police received information about an individual selling illicit liquor in the jurisdiction of PS Akhnoor.

In response to the information, special police teams from PS Akhnoor were formed to address the issue. The operation was led by SDPO Akhnoor Mohan Sharma, assisted by SHO Akhnoor Inspr Zaheer Mushtaq, and I/C PP Jourian PSI Karnail Singh.

The police established a checkpoint at the Jadh area to intercept the suspected person involved in the sale of illicit liquor.

The police successfully intercepted the suspect who was traveling from Akhnoor to Kaleeth area in a vehicle with registration number JK02AN-2483. A search was conducted, leading to the recovery of 200 bottles of illicit liquor from the suspect's possession.

In response to the recovery, a case was registered at PS Akhnoor under FIR No. 255/2023 U/s 48-a, 48-f Exceise Act.

The accused, identified as Parveen Kumar alias Deepu, son of Suraj Singh, and a resident of Dhanger Tehsil Khour District Jammu, was arrested in connection with the case.

The investigation into the case is still ongoing to gather more information and evidence related to the illicit liquor trade.

This operation demonstrates the commitment of the police to combat the illegal sale of liquor in the area and take appropriate legal action against those involved in such activities.

## 2 Kgs Ganja recovered, drug peddler arrested

In this regard, Case FIR No. 271/23 U/S 8/20 NDPS Act got registered at PS Bahu Fort and accused got arrested. Further investigation of the case is going on.
