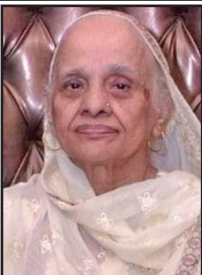

JAMMU: Police on Wednesday foiled a bovine smuggling bid by rescuing 4 bovines and arrested a smuggler.

As per details, a party of Police Post Chowki Chaura assisted by PSI Pankaj Katoch stopped an auto loaded carrier which was coming from Jammu towards Rojauri-Poonch. During interrogation, driver of the auto revealed his name as Jahangir Hussain, son of Faroz Deen, resident of Janyar Poonch. During vehicle checking, four cattle were found loaded in a cruel manner without fodder and water. The vehicle was seized, cattle were rescued and the accused person was arrested on the spot. A case vide FIR No 259 has been registered in this regard.

CRIME REPORT

Police files chargesheet against 3 notorious thieves

SAMBHA: Police on Wednesday filed chargesheet in the court of law against three notorious thieves/receivers of stolen property in a theft case FIR No.12/2023 u/s 379/411 IPC registered at Police Station Bari Brahmana.



During the course of investigation, three thieves/receivers of stolen property were arrested by police and stolen item was recovered. The accused against whom the challan has been produced in the court of law for judicial determination were Ram Kumar, son of Gopi Chand, resident of Koudi Kanthan tehsil Arnas district Reasi; Ashok Kumar Sharma, son of Bittu Sharma, resident of Kanthan Gousal tehsil Arnas district Reasi and Romesh Kumar, son of Ram Kihlwan, resident of Deudtpur tehsil Maheshpurba Bahraich Uttar Pardesh at present Teli Basti Bari Brahmana district Samba. After completing the investigation, police closed the case as challan as offence has been proved against above mentioned three thieves/receivers of stolen property and produced the same in the court of law for judicial determination. The investigation of the case was conducted by PSI Abrar-ul-Haq under the supervision of SHO Police Station Bari Brahmana Sumit Sharma, SDPO Bari Brahmana Rahul Nagar and Additional SP Samba Surinder Choudhary.

Two peddlers arrested; 22 Kgs poppy straw recovered

JAMMU: Continuing its drive against drug trafficking and substance abuse, Police on Wednesday nabbed two drug peddlers and recovered 22 Kgs of poppy straw from two accused persons.

As per details, a team of Police Post Nehru Market led by SDPO South Sachit Sharma assisted by SHO Gandhi Nagar Inspr Pankaj Sharma and In-Charge Police Post Nehru Market SI now Inspr Rohit Gandhi while on patrolling duty rounded up a suspected person who was coming on a vehicle (JK02AP 5697). During search 22 Kgs of poppy straw was recovered from the possession of accused later identified as Raj Kumar, son of Om Parkash and Pinda Kumar, son of Bittu Kumar, both residents of R S Pura. Duo was arrested and FIR No. 221/2023 under sections 8/15/25/29 NDPS Act was registered at Police Station Gandhi Nagar.
