CRIME REPORT

Three drug peddlers arrested; Ganja, cash Rs 43000 recovered

JAMMU: Continuing its drive against drug trafficking and substance abuse, Police on Friday nabbed three drug peddlers and recovered 330 grams of Ganja and cash Rs 43000 from their possession.

As per details, a team of Police S Akhnoor led by SDPO Akhnoor Mohan Sharma assisted by SHO Akhnoor Inspr Zaheer Mushtaq while on Naka duty at Namander near River Chenab Akhnoor rounded up three suspects who were standing at Namander near river Chenab. On search, 330 grams of Ganja was recovered from them.

The accused identified as Bishram Dass, son of Laxman Dass resident of Jio Pota Gatt Akhnoor; Basant Kumar Patel alias Appu, son of Ved Ram, resident of Chhattiagarh at present Sapri Pannu Chowk Akhnoor and Sanjeet Sahu, son of Ganga Sahu, resident of Bihar at present Daskal Akhnoor were arrested and FIR No. 262/2023 under sections 8/20/29 NDPS Act was registered in Police Station Akhnoor.

Bootlegger arrested, 50 bottles of illicit liquor recovered

JAMMU: Police on Friday nabbed a bootlegger and recovered 50 bottles of illicit liquor from their possession.

As per details, an information was received at Police Station Kanachak regarding one bootlegger selling illicit liquor in the area. After this, a team of Police Station Kahnachak led by SDPO Domana Vishal Shoor assisted by SHO Kanachak Insps Sandeep Singh Chib raided at the suspected place and rounded up a suspected person.

During search, 50 bottles of illicit liquor of 180 ML got recovered from his possession.

The accused identified as Balbinder Singh, son of Karan Singh, resident of Mishriwala was arrested and FIR under relevant sections has been registered at Police Station Kanachak.

72 vehicles Challaned, Rs 73000 fine imposed

SAMBA: In order to curb the menace of traffic violations in Samba, Traffic Police Challaned 72 vehicles and realised fine with an amount of seventy two thousands from the violators on spot during the Naka checking in different places of Samba.

According to the report, under the overall supervision of Vinay Kumar Khullar ,SSP Traffic Rural Jammu, DTI Samba Verinder Singh along with team launched special drive against the traffic Violators in different locations of Samba town including border areas. During the checking, the team checked 159 vehicles, in which 72 vehicles were booked and compound challaned in various offences without helmet 55, tripling 5, wrong lane 3, wrong Parking 3, without HSRP 1, using mobile phone 1, Overloading 2 and 1 vehicle is without number plate. A fine of amount Rs.73000 has been realized from the violators.

Police produces Challan against terrorist associate, 2 killed terrorists

SRINAGAR: Police in Pulwama produced challan in case FIR number 97/2023 of Police Station Pulwama in Hon'ble designated NIA Court Pulwama against a terrorist associate and two killed terrorists.

The case has been challaned against a terrorist associate namely Ishfaq Ahmad Wani son of Gh. Nabi resident of Chirat Arigam Pulwama under section 4/5 Explosive Substance Act, 18, 20, 23 & 39 UA (P) Act who has been arrested in the instant case on 07/05/2023 and is presently on judicial remand up to 25/09/2023 lodged in Sub Jail Pulwama by the orders of Hon'ble Designated NIA Court Pulwama and (Abate Challan) against the killed terrorists namely Jamsheed Ahmad Magray son of Ab. Hameed resident of Rajpora and Hanan Bin Yaqoob son

of Mohammad Yaqoob Bhat resident of Kareemabad under section 4/5 Explosive Substance Act, 18, 20, 38 UA (P) Act, who were killed in an encounter with Police & security forces at village Drach Shopian on 05/10/2022.

Two hardcore arrested involved in murder, rape criminals

SAMBA: Police on Friday arrested two hardcore criminals involved in murder case and rape case registered against them at Police Station Bari Brahmana and Police Station Samba. The arrested accused have been identified as Mohd Riaz alias Raju, son of Sayed Ali, resident of Rakh Barotian Tehsil Vijaypur district Samba and Ali Mohd, son of Hasham Din, resident of Batheri tehsil Billawar district Kathua.

Mohd Riaz alias Raju has been arrested in case FIR No. 187/2022 under section 302,307,364,323,427,147,148,201 IPC 4/25 Arms Act registered at Police Station Bari Brahmana in the murder of Zakir Hussain of Balole Khad Bari Brahmana.

Ali Mohd was arrested in case FIR No.222/2023 u/s 376, 313, 506, 420 IPC registered at Police Station Samba through Police Post Rakh AmbTalli as he committed rape on specially abled woman and when she became pregnant, he caused miscarriage without her consent by administering drugs with the intention to destroy evidence, criminally intimidated her not to disclose it to anybody and subsequently to escape from the clutches of police, fraudulently solemnized marriage with her and after some time divorced her by forging her signatures on documents.

The accused have been arrested by the police teams comprising of SHO Police Station Samba Daljit Singh, SHO Police Station Bari BrahmanaSumit Sharma and Incharge Police Post Rakh Amb Talli ASI Ramesh Thakur under the supervision of DySP Garu Ram, SDPO Bari Brahmana Rahul Nagar and Additional SP Samba Surinder Choudhary.

Two drug peddlers arrested with over 34 kg poppy straw

UDHAMPUR : Continuing its drive against drugs in District Udhampur, Police apprehended two drug peddlers and seized 34 kg 240 grams of poppy straw.

A team of Police Post Roundmail led by Insp. Raghunbir Singh SHO Udhampur and assisted by PSI Rahul Jamwal In-Charge Police Post Roundmail under the supervision of Addl. SP Udhampur Anwaar Ul Haq and S. Gurmeet Singh DySP Hqrs. Udhampur laid a Naka at Roundmail naka point for checking.

During Naka checking, police party stopped one Mahindra Xylo (PB07U 4832) which was subjected to thorough search.

During search of said vehicle, 34 kg 240 grams of poppy straw like substance was recovered. The narcotic smugglers namely Amarjeet Singh, son of Gurdyal Singh, resident of Hoshiarpur; Punjab and Raman, son of Ram Dayal, resident of Kapurthala, Punjab were arrested on spot.

The involved vehicle was also seized. FIR NO. 476/2023 under section 8/15 NDPS Acts was registered at Police Station Udhampur.

Notorious criminal arrested under PSA

UDHAMPUR : District Police Udhampur has booked and detained notorious criminal under the J&K Public Safety Act (PSA) for his criminal activities on the detention orders issued by the District Magistrate Udhampur.

The accused namely Rafaqat Ali, son of Mohd. Shafique, resident of Near Devika temple Udhampur booked for his criminal activities in the area for which a number of cases had been registered against him in the Police Station Udhampur. The accused was notorious criminal and are continuously involved in a number of criminal activities.

He has become a threat to the peaceful atmosphere and also posing great threat to the public peace and tranquility thereby forcing authorities to detain them under J&K Public Safety Act.

After getting necessary detention orders Rafaqat Ali was arrested by the team of Police Station Udhampur led by Insp Raghunbir Singh and Dy.SP Hqrs Udhampur S. Gurmeet Singh under supervision of Sh. Anwaar Ul Haq Addional SP Udhampur.

Theft case worked out; accused nabbed, stolen items recovered

UDHAMPUR : Police has worked out a theft case and recovered stolen items with the arrest of accused person.

Based on complaint which was lodged at Police Station Udhampur by a complainant namely Saif Ali, son of Mohd Anwar, resident of Londana Udhampur stating therein that some unknown thieves have stolen some household items from his house.

Acting over the complaint, a case FIR No. 469/2023 under section 457/380 IPC has registered at Police Station Udhampur and investigation started to work out the said theft case.

During the course of investigation, a team of Police Station Udhampur headed by SHO Udhampur Insp. Raghunbir Singh under the supervision of Addl. SP Udhampur Anwaar Ul Haq and DySP Hqrs. S. Gurmeet Singh obtained vital clues with the help of technical assistance and from the scrutiny of CCTV footage of nearby areas and nabbed one suspect namely Mohd. Ameen, son of Mohd. Anwar, resident of Jojdlra Talab, Udhampur.

During sustained questioning, the accused person confess his involvement in said theft and was arrested. On his disclosure stolen items were recovered which include 2 gas cylinders; 1 Electric Motor and 1 Stabilizer.

Further investigation is going on to ascertain the involvement of the accused in other theft cases.

Lifter held, stolen bike nabbed

UDHAMPUR : Police on Friday nabbed a lifter and recovered stolen bike from his possession.

Based on a complaint received from Brij Mohan, son of Naresh Pal, resident of Laddan Udhampur that his motorcycle (JK14G- 4153) has been stolen by some unknown person from outside his house. On this Case FIR No. 474/2023 U/S 380 IPC was registered at Police Station Udhampur and search was started.

During the course of investigation, a team of Police Station Udhampur headed by SHO Udhampur Insp. Raghunbir Singh under the supervision of Addl. SP Udhampur Sh. Anwaar Ul Haq and DySP Hqrs. Gurmeet Singh rounded up several suspects.

During sustained question, one suspect namely Sham Lal, son of Bodh Raj, resident of Ossu Khera, Udhampur broke down and confessed his involvement in lifting of said bike.

The accused person has been arrested and on his disclosure and the stolen bike was recovered.

Rs 1.97 lakh fine recovered for selling misbranded, substandard food items

KATHUA: Court of Adjudicating Officer, Additional District Magistrate Kathua, Ranjeet Singh today imposed fine to the tune of Rs 1.97 lakh on complaint cases/Food Business Operators (FBOs) including manufacturers, wholesale dealers and retailers for violating the provisions of Food Safety and Standards Act-2006.

The fine was imposed on the erring traders, during the proceeding of cases of various blocks of district Kathua related to the Food Safety and Standards Act-2006, listed before the Adjudicating Officer.

He also warned them to abide by the legal regulations adding that non-compliance of Food Safety and Standards Act and rules thereunder by the Food Business Operators of the district will be strongly dealt with .

It is pertinent to mention here that the Concerned Enforcement Agency was directed by the Adjudicating Officer under FSS Act-2006, to take Stern action against the Violators so that Consumers Can be provided wholesome and safe food.

Woman raped by neighbourer
