

This burden is particularly large for patients with inhibitors who can develop serious bleeding complications unresponsive to routine factors and hence more costly by passing agents like rFVIIIa&aPC Care used.

Dr. Kaul explained how an ideal budget can be planned which will provide best possible treatment to persons with Haemophilia (PWH) with or without inhibitors and at the same time can save several lakhs to crores of

He described in detail the application of Health economics and newer technologies like Artificial Intelligence & iCare in Haemophilia that shows a reasonable way to do budget allocations for Haemophilia A & B, by passing

agents and Non factor therapies. He also explained the need for data driven Artificial intelligence based algorithms in solver excel based calculations.

Dr. Kaul's lecture was highly appreciated by the chairpersons and the delegates.
