**Patient jumps to death from 5th floor of GMCH Jammu building**

**JAMMU:** A 38-year-old patient suffering from severe anemia jumped to death from the fifth floor of the Government Medical College (GMC) Hospital here, officials said on Tuesday.

Makhlan Lal, a resident of Bajalta, was admitted to the hospital on Saturday. He jumped out of the hospital building late Monday night, they said.

Preliminary investigation has suggested that Lal might have jumped from the balcony of the ward, police said.

According to officials, his body hitting the ground with a loud sound attracted the attention of some people who rushed him to emergency where Lal succumbed within minutes.

Lal's body was handed over to his family after postmortem. Inquest proceedings have begun.

**2 illegal structures sealed around Ring Road in Sumbal**

**BANDIPORA:** On the directions of the Deputy Commissioner Bandipora, Dr Owais Ahmad, a team led by Nodal Officer Coordination, Mohammad Ashraf Hakak on Tuesday conducted an inspection of the areas adjacent to the Ring Road in Sumbal.

During the inspection, it was given out that the primary objective of the inspection was to assess the current condition of Ring Road and identify any areas that require immediate attention or improvement.

The inspection included a review of the adjacent areas to identify any unauthorized encroachments or land use violations that might hinder the expansion or maintenance of the road.

The team on the spot stopped and sealed 02 illegal constructions taking place along the roadside and directed the concerned owners to ensure change of land use and other building permissions before starting any construction activity.

Moreover 03 other building owners were directed to complete the CLU and other necessary formalities at an earliest.

The Nodal Officer was accompanied by ACR Bandipora Shabir Ahmad, Tehsildar Sumbal, besides a team of engineers, urban development experts, and local administrative officials.

**Illegal constructions: LCMA demolishes various illegally raised structures**

**SRINAGAR:** In order to curb the menace of illegal constructions, the Lake Conservation & Management Authority (LCMA) through its Enforcement Wing today conducted a Routine demolition drive in the area of Brein, Ishber Kral Mohalla, Harwan, Tabilbel, WFR and Dal.

During the drive several illegal constructions were demolished/ removed which includes 01 tin Shed, 03 Hut, 01 tin walling, 01 3rd storey, 01 2nd storey, 01 shop and 01 Single storey. Besides, legal action has also been initiated against the violators.

The Special Demolition Drives will continue within LCMA Jurisdiction especially in Green Belt (200 mts) and the violators will be dealt under law. Therefore, peo-

ple within LCMA Jurisdiction are time and again warned not to resort to any kind of illegal construction/ encroachments within LCMA Jurisdiction especially Green Belt (200 mts).

Moreso, people residing within LCMA residential area are requested to get proper building permission from the competent Authority before taking any construction work in hand, otherwise, strict action shall be taken against them.

**Drug peddler arrested, contraband substance recovered**

**AWANTIPORA:** Continuing its efforts to eradicate the menace of drugs from the society, Police on Tuesday arrested a drug peddler in Awantipora and recovered contraband substance from his possession.

As per details, a party led by SHO Police Station Tral under the supervision of SDPO Tral at a checkpoint established at Nukdi Crossing Bathnoor intercepted a suspicious person.

During search, 570 grams of Charas like substance was recovered from his possession. He has been identified as Nazir Ahmad Sheikh son of Ab Rashid Sheikh resident of Nukdi Bathnoor Tral. He has been arrested and shifted to police station where he remains in custody.

Accordingly, a case vide FIR No. 108/2023 under relevant sections of law has been registered at Police Station Tral and investigation has been initiated.

**Properties of notorious drug peddlers attached**

**PULWAMA:** In a significant move to combat the menace of drug trafficking and to eradicate the menace of drugs from the society, police on Tuesday attached a three-storey residential house and a vehicle belonging to notorious drug peddlers in Pulwama under the NDPS Act 1985.

The three-storey residential house on land measuring 2.1 Marlas valued at approximately 18.17 lakh located in village Naina Batapora, Pulwama belonging to notorious drug peddlers namely Bashir Ahmad Trambooson of Ali Mohd Trambooson and his wife Shahzada Bano resident of Naina Batapora, Pulwama has been attached. The said house was linked to case FIR Nos. 79/2022 under section of 8/15 and 185/2022 under section NDPS Act of Police Station Litter and FIR No. 81/2022 under section 8/21 NDPS Act of Police Station Litter. The investigation proved that the said immovable property was raised/used for Illicit Trafficking by the drug peddler.

In a separate FIR of Police Station Pulwama, Police attached a vehicle (Private swift Dzire) bearing registration No. JK02AW-4505 belonging to drug peddler namely Mohd Yousuf Bhat son of Ab Rehman Bhat resident of Gusoo Pulwama. The said vehicle was linked to case FIR Nos. 79/2022 under section 8/15 NDPS and 185/2022 under section 8/15, 29 of Police Station Pulwama. The investigation proved that the said movable property was raised from Illicit Trafficking by the drug smuggler.

**Police took cognizance of groom running away on day of reception**

**AWANTIPORA:** Police Station Awantipora received a written complaint from one Shazia Akhter against Fayaz Ahmad Dar and his father Mohammad Shahban Dar son of Gh. Qadir Dar residents of Kandizal Awantipora stating there in that her wedding reception was scheduled on 16/09/2023 with Fayaz Ahmad Dar, after performing the Nikah earlier.

However, all the arrangements were put in place for the arrival of the groom along with wedding procession. The said wedding reception was called off at the last moment by the groom side on the pretext that the groom has run away and has refused to attend the reception thereby denying the Nikah which has been performed earlier.

On receipt of this information, Police has taken the cognizance of the matter by registering FIR No 182/2023 under relevant sections of law in Police Station Awantipora against the groom and his father and subsequently both have been arrested. Further investigation in the case is going on.

**Husband arrested for heinous offence on wife's complaint**

A case FIR No. 220/2023 has been registered at Police Station Bari Brahmana and investigation is underway.

**17 bovines rescued, 5 smugglers nabbed**

**REASI:** Continuing special drive against the bovine smuggler Reasi Police foiled bovine smuggling at Pouni.

During Naka checking at Bhambla, one vehicle bearing registration No. JK03B-8711 was intercepted for checking and found 14 bovine animal were being transported illegally without DM permission.

In this cognizance taken and FIR Registered as Case FIR No. 62/2023 u/s 188/IPC 11 1(a) PC Act at Police Station Pouni and arrested accused namely Sahil Ahamad, son of Mohd Ashraf, resident of Malik Market Narwal, Jammu.

While foiling another incident of bovines smuggling, Police team of Police Post Bhambla foiled bovine smuggling bid and rescued 01 bovine animal from persons namely Mohd Aslam, son of Mohd Sharief and Mohd Azam, son of Abdul Hussain both residents of Kothian, Tehsil Pouni, District Reasi at Maghai area of Bhambla.

In this regard, a case FIR No. 63/2023 under sections 188 IPC and 11 (1) (a) PC Act stands registered at Police Station Pouni and accused got arrested in the said case. In another incident, a party of Police Post Bhambla foiled bovine smuggling bid and rescued 02 bovine animal from Mahindra pick up bearing Reg.No JK11D-1645 from the clutches of accused persons namely Ajay Sharma, son of Bishamber Lal, resident of Saranoo Tehsil and District Rajouri and Krishan Singh, son of Lal Chand, resident of Dalhori, Tehsil and District Rajouri.

In this connection a Case FIR No. 64/2023 under sections 188 IPC 11 (1) (a) PC Act stands registered at Police Station Pouni and both the accused arrested.

The whole operation was led by PSI Jasbir Choudhary I/C PP Bhambla and SHO Pouni Purab Singh under the supervision of DySP HQ Reasi Neeraj Padyar-JKPS.

**Missing woman traced, reunited with family**

**REASI:** Police on Tuesday traced a missing woman and reunited her with her family. As per details, One person (name withheld) of Pouni lodged a written complaint on 18th of September 2023 at Police Post Bhambla that her wife (name withheld) went missing. He started searching for her but she could not be found anywhere. Sensing the gravity of incident SSP Reasi Amit Gupta constituted a special team to trace out the missing women at the earliest.

Enquiries from the family, relatives & friends gave sufficient clues of the missing woman & accordingly sources of police were activated.

After meticulous track-following, with the help of technical assistance by ESU Reasi headed by PSI Vivek Choudhary & consistent hectic efforts, team of Police Post Bhambla zeroed upon the location of the woman.

Police team headed by PSI Jasbir Choudhary I/C PP Bhambla raided at different locations and recovered the missing women. The whole operation is led by SHO P/S Pouni Insp.

Purab Singh under the supervision of Dy.SP Hqrs Reasi Neeraj Padyar-JKPS. After completing all the legal formalities the missing women reunited with her family.

**Court rejects bail in attempt to murder case**

**JAMMU:** Electricity Magistrate Vinod Kumar rejected the bail application of one Flix Mattoo involved in attempt to murder case.

Perusal of the Police report reveals that the applicant/accused is involved in case FIR No. 56/2023 for the commission of offences u/s 307/341/323/382/34 IPC and 4/25 Arms Act of Police Station City Jammu.

According to police the victim Zakir Hussain son of Noor resident of Sidhra, Rangura Jammu complained that on 1-9-2023 he went to Bus Stand Jammu to send his wife to Doda/Kishtwar. After his wife boarded a car for the Kishtwar side around 3:00 AM AT bus stand, he started back home on foot. On his way three young men who came on motorcycle made a murderous attack on him, snatched his cash of Rs 15,000 and cut his four fingers and fled from the site on motorcycle. The victim said that he did not know them but can identify them.

Electricity Judge Vinod Kumar after hearing APP Anil Saini for the UT, observed that Supreme Court of India in several judgments have emphasized the importance of custodial interrogations in serious offenses such as Section 307 IPC. In the case of the Joginder Kumar v. State of U.P., (1994) 4 SCC 260, Supreme Court held that custodial interrogations are necessary in cases involving heinous offenses such as murder and attempted murder. The Court also held that denial of bail in such cases is justified to ensure that the accused does not tamper with the evidence or influence witnesses.

Similarly, in the case of Armesh Kumar v. State of Bihar, (2014) 8 SCC 273., the Supreme Court emphasized that bail should not be granted in serious offenses without considering the nature and gravity of the offense, the evidence against the accused, and the likelihood of the accused fleeing from justice. In light of these factors, the court is of the opinion that the accused does not deserve bail at this stage and bail application is hereby rejected.
