
SHRADHANJALI

CRIME REPORT

4 vehicles seized, 4 arrested for illegal extraction and transportation of minerals

BARAMULLA: Acting tough against the persons involved in illegal extraction and transportation of minerals, police have seized 4 vehicles and arrested 4 persons in Baramulla.

A police party led by SHO PS Baramulla seized 4 tippers and arrested 4 drivers identified as Shabir Ahmad Dar son of Gh Mohammad, Shalzad Ahmad Dar son of Gh Mohammad both residents of Jalsheeri Baramulla, Mushtaq Ahmad Mir son of Gh Ahmad resident of Drangbal Baramulla & Javaid Ahmad Lone son of Gh Mohammad resident of Hardushiva Sopore, at Khanpora Baramulla.

The drivers alongwith their vehicles were found involved in illegal extraction and transportation of minerals and accordingly, a case under relevant sections of law was registered in Police Station Baramulla against them and investigation has been taken up.

Court convicts terrorist associate

SRINAGAR: A Court convicted on Friday terrorist associate.

On August 31, 2023, the designate Court after completion of trial in case FIR No. 33/2019 under section 18, 20, 38, 39 UA(P) Act of Police Station Srigufwara convicted a terrorist associate and awarded a fine to the tune of Rs 1 lakh.

The terrorist associate identified as Shahid Fayaz Tarray son of Fayaz Ahmad Tarray resident of Shalagam Bijbehara has been convicted under Section 39 of UA(P) Act.

It is pertinent to mention here that on July 23, 2019 an information was received by Police Station Srigufwara that some unknown hard core terrorist associates of proscribed terrorist outfit JeM are facilitating the terrorists to carry out terrorist acts, motivating youth to join terror ranks and are organising terror module to pay every possible help to strengthen the terror web within the jurisdiction of Police Station Srigufwara etc. On receiving this information, a case FIR No. 33/2019 under section 18, 20, 38, 39 UA(P) Act was registered and investigation was taken up.

During the course of investigation, some suspected hard core terrorist associates were zeroed and were questioned. Subsequently on August, 2020, a checkpoint was established at Darigund Srigufwara during which Shahid Fayaz Tarray son of Fayaz Ahmad Tarray resident of Shalagam Bijbehara was apprehended and was immediately taken into custody and recoveries were made from him.

Missing woman traced, reunited with family

Police produces Challan against 8 notorious thieves

SAMBA: Police on Friday produced challan in the court of law against eight notorious thieves/receivers of stolen property in a theft case of construction company NH-44 "MCCS Infra Pvt. Ltd" registered at Police Station Samba through Police Post Supwal.

On June 30, 2023, a written complaint was lodged at Police Post Supwal by one Rakesh Kumar Dubey, HR Manager Construction Company NH-44 "MCCS Infra Pvt. Ltd." regarding theft of iron plates from construction site. Acting upon the complaint, a case FIR No.162/2023 under section 379 IPC was registered at Police Station Samba through Police Post Supwal and investigation started.

During the course of investigation, eight thieves were arrested by police and stolen items were recovered. The accused against whom the challan has been produced in the court of law for judicial determination are Umesh Pangotra son of Chander Mohan resident of Vijaypur district Samba, Manish Khajuria son of Mahesh Raj resident of Bara tehsil Vijaypur district Samba, Randeep Singh son of Kuldeep Singh resident of Baria tehsil Vijaypur district Samba, Varinder Sharma son of Om Parkash resident of Moutlian Kalan district Samba, Sawan Manjotra son of Tajinder Manjotra resident of Vijaypur district Samba, Rahul Manjotra son of Baljeet Kumar resident of Vijaypur district Samba, Joginder Paul son of Kanthu Ram resident of Samba and Manohar Lal son of Kanthu Ram resident of Samba.

After completing the investigation, police closed the case as challan as offence has been proved against above mentioned eight thieves/receivers of stolen property and produced the same in the court of Additional Special Mobile Magistrate Samba for judicial determination. The investigation of the case was conducted by ASI Balbir Kumar under the supervision of SHO Police Station Samba Rajeshwar Singh, DySPGaru Ram and Additional SP Samba

2 JCBs, tractors involved in illegal mining seized

AWANTIPORA: In continuation to its efforts to curb illegal mining, Tehsildar Awantipora along with officials from Geology and Mining Department carried out a series of raids against illegal mining in twin places of Awantipora and Malangpora of Pulwama district.

Following strict orders from Deputy Commissioner Pulwama, the team conducted raids on several locations. Several vehicles engaged in illegal transportation of minor minerals were confiscated.

Earlier upon receiving inputs of soil excavation going on at Malangpora, the team reached on spot. During the raid, a JCB was caught on spot and handed over to officials of the Geology and Mining Department for seizure.

Meanwhile, raids were carried out at Barsoo, Awantipora as well wherein JCB along with Tractor was caught on spot followed with action by officials from the Mining Department.

It is worth mentioning here to mention that the District Administration Pulwama has adopted a zero-tolerance policy against illegal mining and unauthorized transportation of minerals and people involved in the illegal trade are being dealt with sternly under relevant provision of law.

Inter-district fake marriage racket busted; Four arrest

SRINAGAR: Baramulla Police on Friday busted an inter district fraud marriage racket and arrested four persons. The case was brought to police's attention through an application submitted by some respectable of Kunzer area, police said.

As per details, accused individuals were operating as middlemen during marriage functions. They allegedly used WhatsApp to send photos of various young women, falsely claiming they were ready for marriage. "These individuals convinced the victims on the other side to agree to marriage proposals, fix the mehar money, and make payments. However, despite the financial transactions, no marriages were conducted, and the money was not returned," sources said.

It has been revealed that this group of fraudsters manipulated their victims by selecting targets through carefully chosen photographs of young women, police said, adding that they managed to accumulate a significant sum of 7 lakh 38 thousand rupees from unsuspecting victims under the pretense of mehar payments and commission.

The accused have been identified as Laal Hussain, son of Mir Mohammad, resident of Ward No 06, Jaranwala Gali, Rajouri, Irshada Begum, daughter of Gulzar Ahmad Goger, resident of Mori Kalakot, Rajouri, Ab Rahman Rather, son of Gh Qadir, resident of Dar Mohalla, Drang, Budgam & Ab Khaliq Dar, son of Ab Rahim Dar, resident of Gulab Bag, Pati Poshker, Khag Budgam, it said.

"The Police Department has registered an case FIR under sections of the Indian Penal Code (IPC). An investigation was initiated immediately, leading to the unearthing of the entire fraudulent operation, the sources said.

As of now, four individuals have been apprehended in connection with this case.

Woman police officer heckled
