Jammu & Kashmir besides issues of smart meters, toll plaza, property tax, rising prices and record unemployment. The Congress party led by

During the protest, the Congress members raised strong slogans demanding a CBI probe into the JJM scam, removal of toll plazas, addressing property tax issues, tackling rising prices, and dealing with unemployment.

Congress leaders criticized the government for installing prepaid smart meters, not removing a toll plaza despite it being declared illegal by Minister Nitin Gadkari, imposing property taxes, and for issues related to unemployment and price rise.

Wani called on the people to vote against the BJP in upcoming elections, including ULB, Panchayats, assembly, and Lok Sabha. He also demanded the restoration of statehood and early assembly elections.

Bhalla said that the central government & UT administration are implementing anti people and anti youth decisions to crush the people by various actions & to deprive the people their rights to protest over common issues.
