# CRIME REPORT

## Bootlegger nabbed with 20 litres of illicit liquor

KATHUA: In continuation to take strict action against the consumption/production of illegal liquor menace in the District, Police on Wednesday seized near about 20 litres of illicit liquor and arrested one person.

As per details, a police team led by Insp. Sudhir Sadhotra SHO Police Station Kathua under the supervision of DySP Hqrs. Kathua Manjeet Singh during special checking in its jurisdictional area apprehended one person who was doing the trade of selling illicit liquor to people in order to gain illegitimate profit. On physical checking approximately 20 litres of illicit liquor was recovered from the illegal possession of one person namely Roshan Lal alias Billi, son of Dhian Chand R/o Chak Drab Khan Kathua Tehsil Nagri & District Kathua. He was arrested and FIR No. 426/2023 under section 48(A) Excese Act was registered at Police Station Kathua.

## Bovine smuggler detained under PSA

## Narco smuggler nabbed with 50 gms heroin

in was recovered from the possession of accused later identified as Ajay Chopra, son of Ravi Chopra, resident of Ward No. 2 R.S Pura Jammu at present Qasim Nagar Narwal Jammu. He was arrested and FIR No. 100/2023 under sections 8/21/22 NDPS Act was registered at Police Station Gangyal.

## Notorious bovine smuggler arrested, bovines rescued

## ARTO Bandipora suspends 21 licenses for traffic violations

BANDIPORA: With an aim to ensure road safety and enforcing the traffic regulations, Assistant Regional Transport Officer (ARTO) Bandipora, Bilal Ahmad Mir has taken decisive action against traffic violators by suspending 21 driving licenses.

With the goal of promoting responsible driving and safeguarding lives, Motor Vehicle Department Bandipora has adopted a 'zero tolerance approach' towards traffic regulation violators.

The ARTO said that the recent suspension of 21 driving licenses comes as a strong message to those who flout traffic rules and endanger the lives of themselves as well as the lives of others on the road.

The violations leading to license suspension included not wearing helmets while driving two wheelers, reckless driving, over speeding, and repeated offenses of not wearing seat belts while driving, among others.

He said that repeat offenders will face even stricter action and their license will be cancelled permanently. He said that driving two wheelers without wearing a helmet has been identified as the main cause of many deaths/accidents in Bandipora in the last many years.

Bilal Ahmad Mir said that the department wants to send a clear message that those who disregard the law and put lives at risk will face the consequences.

## Three missing girls traced, reunited with their families

JAMMU/POONCH: Police on Wednesday traced three missing girls and reunited them with their families.

As per details, a written complaint was lodged at Police Station Khour by the legal

heirs of a girl stating that she got missing from her home. In this regard missing report vide DD No 09 Dated Spet 25, 2023 was registered and investigation started. After this, a team of Police Station Khour led by SDPO Akhnoor Mohan Sharma assisted by SHO Khour Insp. Rahul Mahajan did strenuous efforts and traced the missing girl.

Subsequently family of the missing girl was informed and traced girl was handed over to her family members after completing all the legal formalities.

Meanwhile, Poonch Police also recovered two missing minor girls within 12 hours in Mendhar sub division of Poonch district. Police said that these girls, residents of Kasbalari village of Mankot tehsil, went missing recently and in this regard, FIR number 175 under section 363 of IPC was registered at Police Station Mendhar and investigation started.

Keeping in mind the sensitivity of the issue, different police teams were sent to different areas who traced them after making intensive efforts.

## Army jawan injured in landmine blast along LoC

JAMMU: An Army jawan was injured in a landmine blast along the Line of Control (LoC) in Rajouri district on Wednesday, officials said.

The incident took place in the Nowshera forward area when Naik Dheeraj Kumar accidentally stepped on the anti-personnel mine during patrolling, they said.

Kumar, the officials said, was airlifted to the Command Hospital in Udhampur for treatment.
