Court awards 2 years imprisonment to car driver for killing minor

JAMMU: City Judge Jammu Pooja Raina today awarded 2 years imprisonment to Sham Bakshi who killed minor child by his car. According to the police case that on April 16, 2011 P/S Bakshi Nagar received an information that a car bearing No JKS 4200 driven by accused Sham Bakshi negligently, carelessly and rashly was coming towards Bakshi Nagar and on reaching Baby caterers Rehari could not control his car and hit a scooty which was driven by Arun tendon and caused an accident. Due to accident, Arun tendon and his three years son were injured and as a result Adhyan Tandon age 3 years died and accused fled away from the spot. On this police registered a case and after completion of investigation challan was presented. City Judge Jammu Pooja Raina after hearing Special

PP Aseem Sawhney for the UT, observed that since the convict is now aged more than 76 years and was not a driver by profession, therefore, the said consideration also weighs in the mind of the court while awarding sentence as a mitigating circumstance. Accordingly, the convict is sentenced to a simple imprisonment for a period of three months and a fine of rupees one thousand for commission

of the offence under section 279 RPC Further, the convict is sentenced to a simple imprisonment for a period of two years and fine of Rupees two thousand, for the commission of offence under section 304A RPC. In default of payment of fine, the convict shall further undergo simple imprisonment for a period of one month. Both the sentences however, shall run concurrently.

HC frames Robkar against DLR

JAMMU: Justice Vinod Chatterji Koul of Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh High Court framed Robkar against Suhail Hassain Tantray Deputy Legal Remembrancer (DLR) and issued notice to him to show cause as to why he be not punished for having committed contempt of Court. This significant order has been passed in a contempt petition filed by Nawab Din filed SWP No.1928/2006 seeking directions to the State and its functionaries in the Forest Department for his regularization in Government service and release of salary with effect from September 2005. High Court observed that the case was contested by the State and their objections for view of the provisions of the Jammu and Kashmir Daily Rated Workers/Work Charged Employees (Regularization) Rules 1994 and this Court while taking into consideration the claim of the petitioner and objections raised by the State-respondents decided the writ petition with following directions:- "The respondents are, therefore, required to comply with the directions issued in SWP No.1641/01 and the orders passed in COA(S) No.25-A/02. This writ petition, therefore, succeeds. It is, accordingly, allowed with

costs quantified at Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand). A direction shall be issued to the State-respondents to pass requisite orders for petitioner's regularization in service with effect from the date he became entitled thereto after completion of seven years' of continuous daily work service. Remaining Arrears of salary, if any, be released forthwith in his favour." Justice Vinod Chatterji Koul after hearing both the sides observed that respondents in the petition and Suhail Hassain Tantray, who was impleaded as respondent on the previous date of hearing is not present. They were required to remain present to show cause as to why the contempt proceedings be not initiated against them because they have prima facie shown willful disobedience of the orders passed by this Court. Suhail Hassain Tantray by giving his opinion has committed gross contempt, as his opinion regarding counter to the direction passed by this Court. There is no reason shown for their non-appearance. The judgment which is passed in the year 2012 has not been implemented and the non-compliance is willful. The new incumbents, who have appeared in the Court today shall file compliance report as the stated that

they would comply with the judgment within a week's time. A week's time is granted to comply with the judgment in letter and spirit, failing which, they will have to face contempt proceedings. AAG appearing on behalf of the respondents submits that he has made an application for exemption of Suhail Hassain Tantray, Deputy Legal Remembrancer. The said opinion is contrary to the direction passed by the Court and it appears that he has tried to outrage the judgment by giving such opinion. From the perusal of his opinion, it is clear that the judgment passed by this Court will not be implemented. The application which is stated to have been filed for exemption of the said respondent, is not listed today. Even otherwise, having regard to his conduct and the opinion given by him regarding the implementation of the judgment he would not be entitled to exempt. Court held that Prima facie a case is made out that he has committed contempt of Court and directed Registry to frame Robkar against the respondent-Suhail Hassain Tantray and after framing the Robkar issue notice to him to show cause as to why he be not punished for having committed contempt of Court.
