GHAGWAL: Chairman Block Development Council Ghagwal Vijay Tagotra along with his Councillors/Sarpanches has expressed resentment over curtailment of power in Subdivision Ghagwal.

While addressing the media, Tagotra told that it was a burning demand of the local inhabitants of the area for the last eight years regarding installation of 10 MV Power Transformer at Power Station Sandhi road, Ghagwal to overcome the overload of the power station and getting relief from unscheduled curtailments of power.

Further, as per the demand, the said 10 MV Power Transformer was sanctioned and received,

but lying uninstalled at the Power Station for the last eight months which reflect that the Power Development Department has only befooled the general public of the area who are facing lot of inconvenience in their daily life activities. Besides, children and old aged persons are facing acute difficulty

due huge shortage and untimely curtailments of power.

In this connection, the members of Block Development Council Ghagwal hand over a memorandum to DC Samba regarding early installation of 10 MV Power Transformer lying unutilized at the aforesaid

power station. Tagotra further said the power bill should be relaxed by 50% so that the peoples of Ghagwal got the interim relief he also add that if their problem will not solved within days, there is apprehension that they may follow the path of agitation and accordingly the concerned authority shall be responsible for its consequence.
