Recognizing the importance of the Jal Jivan Mission (JJM) and the dire need to augment water supply, the Deputy Commissioner directed the

executive engineers and other concerned officers to work diligently towards achieving the targets set under the Har Ghar Jal initiative. The primary objective is to provide tap water connections to every household, ensuring that the people of Poonch, including those residing in remote areas, can benefit from the JJM scheme and overcome water scarcity. The Deputy Commissioner urged the officers to expedite the execution process, maintain transparency, and ensure that the allotted works are completed within the stipulated time frame.

Now therefore, all previous standing instructions / procedures laid down for the purpose in terms of guidelines / orders shall be treated as superseded by the following procedure :

The Technical Person (Whether applicant & Technical Person as same entity or else) shall complete the dashboard as per below:

- I) Academic / Educational Qualification Tile : Shall fill & upload the documents as per his / her qualification acquired ;
- II) Professional Experience Tile : Shall upload duly attested Experience Certificate as issued by the firm (concerned) alongwith Salary Records for the period of experience gained which shall be duly vetted by Chartered Accountant (CA). It may be noted that no application with experience based on honorary basis shall be entertained for issuance of Wholesale License(s) ;
- III) Technical Registration Tile : Shall upload an affidavit of the Technical Person & Proprietor of firm extending Experience in favor of the person w.r.t contents of Experience Certification. The affidavits shall be duly sworn before the Judicial Magistrate (1st Class) . The details in the Technical Registration Tile shall be filled as per contents of Affidavit / Experience Certificate.
