# EEO conducts second inspection of Election Expenditure Registers

ANANTNAG: The Election Expenditure Observers (EEO) for Anantnag district, Tamil Selvam and Vinay Kumar Arya on Tuesday conducted the second review of the expenditure registers for all contesting candidates in the ongoing General Assembly elections here.

The review meeting was held in the presence of election officials and representatives of contesting candidates, ensuring transparency and adherence to election expenditure norms. This review is part of

the district's ongoing efforts to ensure accountability in the electoral process.

A team of senior officials, including the Nodal Officer of the Expenditure Monitoring Cell, examined the records submitted by candidates to ensure compliance with the guidelines established by the Election Commission of

The District Administration remains committed to conducting a free, fair, and transparent election process. Polling for the Assembly Constituencies in District Anantnag is scheduled for 18th September as part of the first phase of polling in Jammu and Kashmir.

Officer at block level and sharing of his contact numbers with ROs, Presiding Officers and Sector Magistrates.

Dy:DEO was directed to visit election training centers and inspect the quality of the refreshments being provided to the employees.

Ayushi emphasized the importance of robust welfare preparations for poll staff to facilitate a smooth electoral process.
