NOK's of those 14 peoples DFSS holds protest against Pakistan

JAMMU: The workers of Dogra Front & Shiv Sena $\left(\text{DFSS}\right)$, under the leadership of President Ashok Gupta, held a massive protest rally in Jammu city to condemn the martyrdom of two Indian Army soldiers, Naib Subedar Vipan Kumar and Sepoy Arvind Singh, who lost their lives in a gunbattle in Kishtwar.

The protest included the burning of an effigy of Pakistan's Prime Minister Shahbaz Sharif, symbolizing the group's anger towards Pakistan's alleged role in supporting terrorism in Jammu and Kashmir. Expressing his anguish, Ashok Gupta paid tribute to the fallen soldiers, stating, "I am deeply anguished to learn about the cowardly attack on our Army soldiers in Kishtwar. Tributes to brave soldiers who

made the supreme sacrifice protecting our nation. My deepest condolences to the bereaved families." Gupta emphasized that the Over Ground Worker (OGW) network, which provides support to terrorists, must be dismantled. He argued that eliminating local support would make it impossible for terrorists to hide or survive in the jungles for long periods. Gupta called for a strong attack against Pakistan to put an end to its support for terrorism, asserting that a united response is needed to eliminate such threats globally.
