JAMMU: District Social Welfare Department on Thursday hosted sports events at Louis Braille School for sightless girls Roonagar to spread voter awareness among the specially abled students and encourage them to exercise their right to vote in the J&K Assembly Elections-2024.

Around 300 people, including school students, government functionaries and civil society members participated in the program.

District Social Welfare Officer Mamta Rajput and her team informed the students regarding the special facilities available for Persons with Disabilities (PWDs) at polling booths and the use of SAKSHAM App launched by ECI. The awareness program was held under the SVEEP initiative.

SRINAGAR: Home voting via Postal Ballot, for the Assembly election has officially begun on Thursday across all eight constituencies of District Srinagar, utilizing postal ballots to facilitate the voting process. This initiative is specifically aimed at enhancing electoral participation among voters aged 85 and older, as well as persons with 40% bench mark disability.

The Home Voting process will continue for three days, until September 21, 2024. Dedicated staff members, including polling personnel, micro-observers, and reserves, are deployed across various clusters in the constituencies. The district administration has identified a substantial number of eligible home voters (AVSC & AVPD).

District Election Officer (DEO) Dr. Bilal Mohi-ud-Din reaffirmed the district administration's commitment to inclusivity, free, fair and transparent elections stating, "We aim for 100% voter participation ensuring that every eligible individual exercise their franchise.

This process is conducted under the supervision of election observers from ECI and senior officials, with micro-observers in place to guarantee transparency and integrity. The administration remains steadfast in maintaining high standards of security and electoral integrity throughout this important initiative.

In terms of instructions issued by the Election Commission of India on the subject, it is brought to the notice of public in general, all Contesting Candidates/ Political parties that the following dates are hereby notified for Home Visits by the polling teams in respect of the Absentee Voters in the category of Senior Citizens (AVSC), Persons with Disabilities (AVPD) and COVID-19 Suspect or Affected Persons (AVCO), who have opted for the same in the three Assembly Constituencies of District Samba viz- 69-Ramgarh (SC) / 70-Samba / 71-Vijaypur as per the following schedule:-

The team of Polling Officers shall visit the electors at the address mentioned in their application in Form 12D for facilitating their voting by postal ballot. The electors will be intimated, in advance, about the date and approximate time of visit of the Polling teams.


If the elector is not present at the given address during the first visit of the polling party on **24th September, 2024 (Tuesday)**, the team shall pay a second visit after leaving an intimation about the time of second visit i.e **25th September, 2024 (Wednesday)**. If the elector is not present even during the second visit, no further visit or action is required in the case.

The list of AVSCs, AVPDs and AVCOs shall be divided for distribution among the different teams of Poll Officers in such a manner that each team gets a list of persons in geographically compact area. The concerned ARO shall prepare a route plan of the teams by mapping of the eligible households falling in such category and share the same with this office at the earliest.

Police security cover shall be provided to the Polling Officers during their visits. Arrangement for videography of the proceedings at the address of Absentee Voters shall be made in such a manner that secrecy of vote is not violated at any stage.

The detailed guidelines issued in this regard by the Election Commission of India are enclosed herewith for ready reference.
