POONCH: With the Assembly Elections approaching, District Election Officer (DEO) Poonch, Vikas Kundal, on Thursday visited Surankote and Mendhar to oversee the preparations for the upcoming Assembly polls. The DEO reviewed arrangements related to the election and enforcement of MCC.

Additionally, DEO Kundal met with the Systematic Voters' Education and Electoral Participation (SVEEP) teams, urging them to expedite their awareness campaigns across the district. The initiative is crucial for maximizing voter participation ahead of the Assembly elections, scheduled on September 25.

The DEO also engaged with the Returning Officers (ROs) of Surankote and Mendhar, who updated him on their preparations, ensuring that all necessary arrangements are in place for a smooth electoral process.

Furthermore, he instructed the ROs to finalize all preparations and reviewed the ongoing home voting status. Emphasizing inclusivity, he stressed the need to achieve 100 percent polling for voters aged 85 and above, as well as for persons with disabilities, within the stipulated time frame.
