

## Joint intelligence, security meeting held at Mamun Cantonment

**PATHANKOT:** Aiming to enhance security and foster inter-agency cooperation, a joint intelligence and security meeting was held at the Mamun Cantonment here, according to an official statement issued here on Saturday.

The meeting was attended by officials from the army, police, Border Security Force and intelligence agencies.

The meeting, which lasted almost two hours, was chaired by Lt Gen Rajan Sharawat, GOC 9 Corps. Major General Vikram Sharma, GOC Gurj Division, and Deputy Inspector General of Police (DIG) of Jammu-Samba-Kathua Range (JSK) Range, Shiv Kumar Sharma were also present.

The meeting was also attended by DIG Pathankot-Amritsar Range Sukhjinder Singh, SSP Kathua Deepika, SSP Pathankot and other officers. The aim was to review current security protocols, assess recent challenges, and

Emphasis was placed on enhancing real-time communication between the Army and other civil intelligence and law-enforcement agencies to improve response times and operational efficiency during crises.

All entities reviewed protocols for intelligence-sharing, ensuring that information critical to regional and local security is accurately and promptly exchanged ensuring timeliness and optimum response, it said.

The meeting also involved a detailed review of current crisis response strategies, with an eye on refining procedures to better address complex and evolving threats.

Recognising the importance of public trust and cooperation, both agencies discussed strate-

gies to enhance community outreach and engage with residents to promote safety and security, it said.

"This review meeting signifies a crucial step towards fortifying our collective security efforts. By strengthening our collaboration and Inter-Agency

coordination we are better equipped to respond to challenges and protect our nation and its citizens," said the statement.

The joint security review meeting concluded with a shared commitment to ongoing collaboration and continuous improvement in security practices.

All the agencies reaffirmed their dedication to working together seamlessly to address any potential threats and ensure the well-being of the public, it added.

**PUBLIC NOTICE**

It is hereby informed to all registered Printers/Publishers, all the political parties and prospective candidates for the forthcoming Jammu and Kashmir Legislative Assembly Election 2024 that all have to abide by the restrictions on printing of pamphlets/posters/banners/buntings etc. to be used for campaigning in 80-Marh(SC) Assembly Constituency as per the provision of Section 127-A of the Representation of People Act, 1951 which is re-produced here under:-

**"127A. Restrictions on the printing of pamphlets, posters, etc. -"**

(1) No person shall print or publish, or cause to be printed or published, any election pamphlet or poster which does not bear on its face the names and addresses of the printer and the publisher thereof.

(2) No person shall print or cause to be printed any election pamphlet or poster -

Unless a declaration as to the identity of the publisher thereof, signed by him and attested by two persons to whom he is personally known, is delivered by him to the printer in duplicate; and

Unless, within a reasonable time after the printing of the document, one copy of the declaration is sent by the printer, together with one copy of the document -

(a) Where it is printed in the capital of the State, to the Chief Electoral Officer; and

(b) in any other case, to the District Magistrate of the district in which it is printed.

(3) For the purposes of this section:-

(a) any process for multiplying copies of a document, other than copying it by hand, shall be deemed to be printing and the expression "printer" shall be construed accordingly;

(b) "election pamphlet or poster" means any printed pamphlet, and-bill or other document distributed for the purpose of promoting or prejudicing the election of a candidate or group of candidates or any placard or poster having reference to an election, but does not include any handbill, placard or poster merely announcing the date, time, place and other particulars of an election meeting or routine instructions to election agents or workers.

(4) Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of sub-section (1) or sub-section (2) shall be punishable with imprisonment for a term which may extend to six months, or with fine which may extend to two thousand rupees, or with both."

Accordingly, all the registered printers/publishers, all political parties and prospective candidates are enjoined upon to adhere to the above instructions in letter and spirit failing which legal action as warranted under rules shall be initiated against defaulters.

It is notified for the information of eligible candidates of NEET UG-2024 whose names are figuring in the Provisional Merit List (PML) issued by the Board vide Notification No. 084-BOPEE of 2024 dated 25-08-2024 and who are interested for admission in MBBS Course in ASCOMS - Jammu under Hindu Minority and NRI Quota that they shall submit their relevant documents on the prescribed format at the BOPEE Office Srinagar/Jammu w.e.f 1<sup>st</sup> September, 2024 to 5<sup>th</sup> September, 2024 (III 03:00 P.M). The details of the seats are given herein under:

**A. The number of seats for MBBS course as available in ASCOMS-Jammu under Hindu Minority / NRI Quota: -**

- Hindu Minority Quota Seats - 25
- NRI Seats - 10

**B. The NRI / Hindu Minority Quota seats for MBBS in ASCOMS Jammu shall be filled up through a process of Physical/Online counselling, the schedule for which shall be notified separately by the Board.**

**Important Note:**

- The last date for submission of the documents under NRI/Hindu Minority Quota physically at BOPEE office Jammu/Srinagar is: **05-09-2024 (III 03:00 P.M).**
- The check list Proforma for Hindu Minority (HM) / NRI is available as **Annexure A & B** to this Notification only on the official website of BOPEE i.e. [www.jkbpeee.ac.in](http://www.jkbpeee.ac.in) only.

**General Conditions: - The candidates applying for NRI/HM Quota seats:**

- should have applied under NEET-UG-2024 and have qualified /obtained minimum score of 162; and
- should also have uploaded other documents except HM/NRI certifications during registration process on BOPEE website in response to the Notification No. 084-BOPEE of 2024 dated 25- 08-2024.

**Fee Structure:-**

The Tentative fee fixed by the Government of J&K for MBBS seats in ASCOMS vide Government Order No. 659-HME of 2019 dated 10-07-2019 is given as under: -

**MBBS in ASCOMS**

- Government Seats under OM/HM -Rs. 4.95 lacs per annum per student
- NRI Seats - US Dollars \$ 21, 522

The above fee structure is purely tentative and the candidates applying under HM/NRI Quota should confirm the admission fee from the concerned college before applying for it.

**Eligibility for NRI Seats:-**

**Category No. 1: -** Whereas an applicant himself/herself is NRI and family originally belongs to the UT of J&K.

**Category No. 2: -** Children/wards of NRI, who originally belongs to the UT of J&K.

Further, the documents required for NRI Category 1 and 2 are as under: -

**Category No. 1:**

- NEET UG-2024 Score Card;
- NRI certificate issued by the Ministry of External Affairs, Government of India or Indian Embassy Overseas under Ministry of External Affairs with holding of Indian Passport;
- Copy of NRI Bank Account preferably in the country where the candidate is residing or of NRI Account in India;
- Copy of Indian Passport;
- Copy of Income Tax Return filed in India, if any;
- PAN Card;
- Domicile Certificate of the candidate.
- Any other document as may be required by the Board for its satisfaction.

**Category No. 2:**

- NEET UG-2024 Score Card;
- NRI Sponsorship Letter;
- Undertaking of NRI duly attested by the legal authority of that country where sponsor is residing or Indian Embassy Overseas;
- Bank Statement of the Sponsor;
- Resident/National Certificate or NRI certificate of the sponsor;
- Pedigree Table/Family Tree establishing relationship of the candidate with the sponsor along with documentary Proof;
- Employment certificate of the sponsor;
- PAN Card of the sponsor;
- PAN Card, if any of the candidate/parents;
- Copy of Income Tax Return filed, if any
- Domicile Certificate of the candidate.

The prescribed formats as **Annexure A & B** to this Notification are available only on the official website [www.jkbpeee.ac.in](http://www.jkbpeee.ac.in) of the board.

**Note:-**

- The seats shall be filled up purely on the basis of Eligibility and Merit of the candidates secured in the NEET-UG 2024.
- Only such candidates shall be eligible, who have registered themselves online and figured in the UT Provisional Merit List as notified by the Board vide Notification No. 084-BOPEE of 2024 dated 25-08-2024
- The candidate applying under Hindu Minority Quota shall be required to produce a certificate from the Competent Authority that he/she belongs to the Hindu Minority (HM) Community.
- Only Domiciles of UT of J&K are eligible to compete against the above seats of HM and NRI.
- The eligibility under NRI shall be subjected to such other conditions as may be notified by the Competent Regulatory Body of the Government of India / UT Government or such orders of the Hon'ble Court applicable on the subject.
- Merit submission of the documents does not confer any right of the candidate for admission unless and until the eligibility is verified by the board.
