During the visit, the team engaged with the principal, Staff and several parents to explore opportunities for enhancing the school's functioning. A significant focus of the discussions was on integrating local knowledge into the curriculum, allowing students to connect with their tribal culture and traditions. This approach aims to enhance their understanding of

age-old practices within their community while providing a modern educational experience. Additionally, it was brought to the Secretary's attention that the land transfer for EMRS has not yet been completed, which is a pressing issue. The Secretary acknowledged this concern and promised that immediate action will be taken to resolve the matter.

JAIPUR: The joint military exercise between the armies of India and the US ended after the closing ceremony of the training activity was held at the Mahajan Field Firing Range on Saturday, officials said. The 20th edition of bilateral drills 'Yudh Abhyas-24' was focused on counterterrorism operations in semi-urban and semi-desert terrain under the United Nations mandate, they said. "The exercise emphasised physical fitness, tactical drills, and the exchange of best practices, techniques, and procedures between the two armies, which was clearly demonstrated during the closing ceremony," the defence spokesperson said in a release. The Indian contingent was represented by Infantry Brigade Headquarters and a battalion group of the Rajput

Regiment of the Amogh Division, while the US contingent included the 1-24 Infantry Battalion and elements from the 11th Airborne Division based in Alaska. Over 1,200 personnel participated in this enduring exercise, braving the harsh terrain and climate of the Thar desert, the

spokesperson said. The exercise was conducted in two phases. The first phase involved combat conditioning and tactical training, where both contingents successfully completed joint training to improve their operational synergy. In the second phase, the validation stage, the training

was put into practice through a series of joint operations, the spokesperson said. A command planning exercise was also conducted simultaneously to validate planning, techniques, tactics, and procedures, further enhancing jointmanship and interoperability, the statement said.

3. The concerned Nodal Officer shall prepare a route plan of the teams by mapping of the eligible households falling in such category and share the same with this office at the earliest.

4. Police security cover shall be provided to the poll officers during their visits arrangement for Videography of the proceedings at the address of Absentee Voters shall be made in such a manner that secrecy of vote is not violated at any stage.

5. The detailed guidelines issued in this regard by the Election Commission of India shall be followed in letter and spirit.

In pursuance of Notification No.111-BOPEE of 2024 dated 16.09.2024 the second round of counselling (Physical) for remaining seats reserved for allotment/upgradation to the candidates of horizontal reservations (CDP, JKPM, Sports category and PwD) for admission to B.Sc. Nursing/B.Sc. Paramedical / B.Sc. Technology Courses 2024 in Government Colleges /Institutions of the UT of J&K was held on 19-09-2024. The list of candidates who have been upgraded/allotted seats provisionally for undergoing B.Sc. Nursing/B.Sc. Paramedical / B.Sc. Technology Courses 2024 in various Government Colleges/Institutions of UT of J&K, is hereby notified as per **Annexure-A** to this Notification, which shall remain available on website of the Board viz. www.jkbopee.gov.in only. The candidates shall report to the Colleges allotted to them w.e.f. **21.09.2024 to 26.09.2024** along with the following documents in original for admission:

- Date of Birth Certificate.
- Marks Card of 10+2.
- Domicile Certificate.
- Category Certificate, if any, applicable.
- Paramedical (12th Based) Diploma, (For Lateral Entry candidates only).
- Any other certificate as may be required by the College Authorities.

The candidates provisionally selected for Up-gradation/Allotment shall mandatorily have to report for admission to the allotted College/Institutions by or before **26.09.2024 upto 4:00 p.m.** along with their relevant certificates in original, failing which they shall not be eligible for further rounds of counselling, if any, conducted by the Board.

The Colleges shall have to submit the shortfall, if any, on **26.09.2024 upto 5:00 p.m.** positively to enable the Board to take further necessary action in the matter.

Note:

- All the Heads of the Institutions/Colleges are advised to release the documents and refund the fee in favour of such candidates who have been upgraded to enable them to complete the admission process within the prescribed cut-off date (**26.09.2024**) without facing any difficulty.
- All the Heads of the Institutions/Colleges are requested to keep their admission counters open on holidays/off days to facilitate the candidates to complete their admission process well in time. However, the candidates should, in their own interest, avoid waiting for the last day to complete the admission formalities as such delay has the potential of causing hardships to the candidates only.
- The admission of the candidates is purely provisional and shall be liable to be cancelled in case any information furnished by any candidate proves to be false/ fabricated, and action as warranted under law shall be initiated against such candidates.
- It is hereby implored upon the management of all Colleges/ Institutions to ensure the veracity of documents, particularly the Category Certificates wherever the admission is to be granted in lieu of a Reserved Category. So far as the Persons with Disability are concerned, if selected under Open Merit or against a Reserved Category, it shall be ensured that his/her PwD Certificate/eligibility is in conformity with Indian Nursing Council (INC)/Paramedical/Nursing Council UT of J&K Guidelines / Regulations framed by the concerned Regulatory Body and wherever required shall refer the matter to the concerned Medical Board to assess such candidate(s) and make recommendations based on which institution(s) shall take further necessary action. In case any candidate does not fulfill the benchmark of disability as notified by Government from time to time and also as per INC/ Paramedical/Nursing Council UT of J&K Guidelines, his/her admission shall be cancelled on his/her own risk and responsibility under intimation to the Board. The candidate(s) if any found to have concealed any information, his/her selection/admission shall be cancelled abinitio and fine/penalty shall be imposed upon him/her as may be deemed proper by the board in accordance with the laid down rules.

The Heads of the Institutions shall keep record of admissions and send the shortfall of the candidates, if any, who have not completed their admission within the prescribed time mentioned above through E-mail viz. coejkbopee@gmail.com & helpdesk@jkbopee@gmail.com upto **26.09.2024 at 5:00 p.m.** positively along with hard copy duly signed by the Head of the Institution.
