**Subject: Conduct of General Elections to the Legislative Assembly 2024-
Imposition of restrictions under Section 163 Bharitya Nagarik
Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS) - regarding.**

Whereas, Polling for General Elections to the Legislative Assembly-2024 for District Udhampur is scheduled on **01st of October 2024** (Phase III);

Whereas, it is essential to conduct the Elections in a free, fair and transparent manner and it is equally important to maintain public peace, order and tranquility as per the Law and Model Code of Conduct, as applicable with effect from 16-08-2024;

Whereas, under Section 126 of the Representation of People Act 1951, no public meetings, processions, musical concert or rally or any kind of propagation of any election matter for campaigning or electioneering is to be allowed in the last 48 hours from the time of close of Poll i.e. **from 06:00PM on 29-09-2024 to 06:00 PM on 01-10-2024;**

Whereas, I am satisfied that the circumstances do not permit to serve the notices individually upon the persons against whom this order is directed and therefore, under the powers vested in me under sub section (2) of Section 163 of Bhartiya Nagrik Surakshah Sanhita 2023, I, hereby pass the order ex-parte;

Now, therefore, **I, Saloni Rai (IAS), District Magistrate, Udhampur**, in exercise of the powers vested in me under the provision of Section 163 of Bhartiya Naagrik Surakshah Sanhita 2023, do hereby order that:

A. Prohibition of public meetings during period of forty-eight hours ending with hour fixed for conclusion of poll :-

1) No person shall :-

- convene, hold, attend, join or address any public meeting or procession in connection with an election; or
- display to the public any election matter by means of cinematograph, television or other similar apparatus; or
- propagate any election matter to the public by holding, or by arranging the holding of, any musical concert or any theatrical performance or any other entertainment or amusement with a view to attracting the members
- of the public thereto; in any polling area during the period of forty-eight hours ending with the hour fixed for the conclusion of the poll.

B. Prohibition of canvassing in or near polling station:-

1) No person shall, on the date on which poll is taken at any polling station, commit any of the following acts within the polling station or in any public or private place within a distance of (one hundred meters) of the polling station, namely:-

- canvassing for votes; or
- soliciting the vote of any elector; or
- persuading any elector not to vote for any particular candidate; or
- persuading any elector not to vote at the election; or
- exhibiting any notice or sign (other than an official notice) relating to the election.

C. Dry Day shall be observed in the District from 29-09-2024 (6:00PM) to 01-10-2024 (06:00PM) & 08.10.2024 and all restrictions provided in Excise Law on the storage of Liquor in unlicensed premises shall be vigorously enforced.

D. The below mentioned restrictions shall remain in force on Poll Day i.e. 01st of October, 2024:

- a. One vehicle for candidate, one vehicle for Election agent and one vehicle for the agent/party worker shall be allowed to play on the poll day and no other vehicle would be allowed to be used by any Candidate.
- b. The permission/permits issued by RO shall be displayed on the windscreen of the vehicles and no other vehicle shall be allowed to be used by any Candidate of the political parties. Carrying of voters by these vehicles amounts to corrupt practices u/s 133 and is liable for penal action u/s 123(5) of RP Act, 1951.
- c. No person other than the candidate shall be allowed to use the vehicle allotted to the candidate.
- d. Providing of free conveyance to voters to and from the polling stations by the Candidates/agents shall be strictly forbidden.
- e. There shall be prohibition of loud speakers; mega phones etc. and no person shall create disorderly conduct within 100 meters of a Polling Station.
- f. No person shall canvass for votes or solicit the vote of any elector or persuade any elector not to vote at the election or exhibit any notice or sign (other than an official notice) relating to election within a distance of 100 meters of Polling Station, and no campaign related posters/banners within 100mtrs of Polling Booth shall be allowed.
- g. The Voter slips shall be plain white slips without the name of candidate/party markings/symbol.
- h. Cellular Phones, Cordless phones etc. shall not be allowed except for officers on duty in the 100 meters of a Polling Station.
- i. No booth shall be set up within a distance of 200 meters from the Polling Stations. Even where more than one Polling Station has been set up in the same Location or premises, there shall be only one booth of a candidate for such group or Polling Stations beyond a distance of 200 meters from such premises.
- j. Amplifying or reproducing the human voice by any apparatus is not allowed within 100 meters from the Polling Station.
- k. Security personnel attached to any person is not allowed inside the polling booth, except in case of a person covered under Z+ security category with one Security person in simple clothes with one concealed Arm.

However, the above order shall not apply to Officers authorized on Election Duty by the District Election Officer, Udhampur, including the Polling Officials/Officers, Magistrates, Police Officials and Government Staff.

Failure to comply with the aforementioned instruction shall invite penal action as envisaged under law.
