Gross neglect of Guru Nanak Dev Ji's Chair established in JU : Balvinder

JAMMU: Balvinder Singh, a prominent RTI activist and president of the Sikh Progressive Front, has expressed profound disappointment regarding the neglect of the Guru Nanak Dev Chair at Jammu University. Established with the approval of the Higher Education Department, the Chair was inaugurated on November 27 by Hon'ble LG Sh. Manoj Sinha, alongside Mahant Manjit Singh ji, aiming to promote Guru Nanak Dev Ji's legacy.

Singh emphasized that the Chair was intended to foster research into Guru Nanak's teachings, enhancing understanding of his contributions to spirituality, social justice, and interfaith dialogue. This initiative is crucial for preserving Sikh heritage and fostering harmony among diverse communities. However, revelations from an RTI filed at Jammu University paint a disheartening picture.

The RTI indicates that in the past four years, not a single rupee has been spent on research activities associated with the Chair. While Rs. 5 lakhs were sanctioned, only Rs. 2.5 lakhs have been



released, with Rs. 1.5 lakhs spent on furniture and miscellaneous expenses, leaving Rs. 1 lakh unutilized. Additionally, no permanent Chair professor or research scholars have been appointed, representing a severe neglect of Guru Nanak Dev Ji's teachings.

Singh noted a growing resentment among the Sikh community towards the LG administration and Jammu University, particularly over unfulfilled promises regarding the promotion of the Punjabi language.

Vacancies for essential faculty positions in the Punjabi Department have remained unaddressed for over a decade.

He has called for immediate action to rectify these issues, urging accountability from the involved authorities and stressing that the disrespect shown to the Chair is intolerable.

"NC-Congress supporting terrorism in J&K" People must give BJP strong mandate for comprehensive development: Ravinder Raina

JAMMU: The Jammu and Kashmir BJP President, Ravinder Raina, on Saturday criticized the National Conference (NC) and Congress, accusing them of trying to secure the release of terrorists and stone pelters, while contrasting their actions with Prime Minister Narendra Modi's relentless efforts to uplift the poor. Raina asserted that while Modi has been dedicated to the welfare of the underprivileged, NC and Congress have shown a dangerous inclination towards supporting terrorism and jeopardizing the hard-earned peace in the region.

Ravinder Raina highlighted the Modi government's historic welfare initiatives, stating, "Prime Minister Modi provided free houses, free ration, free LPG cylinders, and health insurance of ₹5 lakh to the poor; while NC-Congress never cared for the marginalized sections of society. The Modi Government has proven to be the true well-wisher of the poor and backward communities." He emphasized that unlike Modi's people-centric policies, NC has repeatedly demonstrated its support for terrorism, with public promises to release terrorists and

stone pelters if elected, a move Raina described as a clear attempt to revive militancy in Jammu and Kashmir.

Raina further accused the NC-Congress alliance of harboring close ties with Pakistan, which he said have been exposed by recent statements from Pakistan's Defense Minister, Khawaja Asif. "The NC-Congress nexus with Pakistan is evident, and the people of Jammu and Kashmir must teach these parties a lesson in the upcoming elections," he urged. He confidently predicted that there is a strong wave in favor of BJP and that it would form the next government in Jammu and Kashmir based on its record of service and development.

Ravinder praised the BJP's performance in the Lok Sabha elections, attributing the victories to Prime Minister Modi's commitment to the people, as encapsulated in his principle of "Sabka Saath, Sabka Vikas." He pointed out that the Modi government has extended rights and benefits to every neglected section in Jammu and Kashmir, urging voters to support BJP in the assembly elections to continue this legacy of inclusive growth.

Raina detailed the significant



infrastructure developments initiated by the Modi government in Jammu and Kashmir, including the construction of two AIIMS, multiple medical colleges, improved road networks, ring roads, highways, and new universities. He also commended the efforts of the local MP for bringing several key projects to his constituency, resulting in better roads, enhanced drinking water supply, and other essential facilities that testify to the BJP-led government's commitment to the region's progress.

Paying tribute to the brave soldiers of the nation, Raina reaffirmed BJP's stance that the nation always comes first. He assured that the Modi government would continue to empower the security forces to take decisive action against

terrorists and their sponsors, ensuring national security remains uncompromised.

In preparation for the upcoming assembly elections, Raina called on BJP leaders and workers to remain vigilant and dedicated, reminding them that their service to the nation must be unwavering. He outlined BJP's manifesto commitments, highlighting key promises such as expanding the Ayushman Bharat Sehat Scheme with an additional Rs 2 lakh coverage, adding 1,000 new seats to government medical colleges, and enhancing the PM Kisan Samman Nidhi by Rs 4,000 to benefit farmers in Jammu and Kashmir.

Raina further announced reforms for government employees, including reservation in promotions for Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes, and a transfer policy for Scheduled Caste employees working in the Kashmir Valley. He also promised the construction of 10,000 km of rural roads to connect every village, along with completing critical projects like the Sadhna Pass Tunnel and the Katra-Banihal Railway

Tunnel under the 'Har Tunnel Tex Pahal' Yojana for seamless connectivity.

Addressing employment issues, Raina committed to resolving the grievances of long-serving ad-hoc, contractual, and daily wage employees, along with providing targeted support for community workers such as Anganwadi Workers, ASHAs, NHM workers, Rehbar-e-Khel employees, CIC operators, Home Guards, and National Youth Corps. Additionally, he pledged to expedite metro services in Jammu and Srinagar to improve urban connectivity and mobility.

In his concluding remarks, Raina urged the people of Jammu and Kashmir to support BJP in the assembly elections, promising that the party would bring transformative changes, bolster development, and safeguard peace and security in the region. He assured voters that with BJP at the helm, Jammu and Kashmir will witness unprecedented growth and prosperity, ensuring that the legacy of Prime Minister Narendra Modi's governance continues to uplift every citizen.

The candidates shall have to report to the respective Colleges/Institutions allotted to them for completion of admission process upto **04.10.2024 (till 04:00 p.m.)** from the date of uploading of this Notification on the official website of BOPEE along with the following documents in original:

- Domicile Certificate.
- 12th Class Marks Card.
- D.O.B. Certificate/10th Class Marks Card issued by the Board.
- Category Certificate, wherever applicable.
- NEET 2024 score card.
- Any other document as may be required by the College Authorities.

The provisionally selected candidates shall have to mandatorily report for admission to the allotted Colleges/Institutions by or before **04.10.2024 upto 04:00 p.m.** along with their relevant certificates/documents in original, failing which they shall not be eligible for further round of counseling, if any, conducted by the Board.

The Colleges shall submit the shortfall, if any, on **04.10.2024 upto 05:00 p.m.** positively to enable the Board to take further appropriate action in the matter.

Note:

- The admission of the candidates shall be purely provisional and liable to be cancelled in case any information furnished by any candidate(s) proves to be false / fabricated and action as warranted under law shall be initiated against them.
- If any candidate(s) is found to have concealed any information, his/her selection/admission shall be cancelled ab-initio and fine/penalty shall also be imposed upon him / her as may be deemed proper by the Board in accordance with the laid down rules.
- All the provisionally selected candidates are advised to visit their respective allotted College/Institution for fee and other relevant documents required by respective colleges.
- It is the responsibility of the concerned Heads of the Institutions/Colleges to check and verify the documents and eligibility of the provisionally selected candidates before allowing them to join in their respective Institutions/College.
- It is hereby implored upon the management of all Colleges/Institutions to ensure the veracity of documents, particularly the Category Certificates wherever the admission is to be granted in lieu of a particular Reserved Category. So, far as the Persons with Disability are concerned, if selected in open merit or against a Reserved category it shall be ensured that his/her PwD Certificate/eligibility is in conformity with Guidelines / Regulations mentioned under PwD disability Act 2016 and rules thereunder with benchmark of disabilities as identified by Govt. for relevant field and wherever required shall refer the matter to concerned Medical Assessment Board to assess the veracity of disability of such candidates and make recommendations based on which Institutions shall take further necessary action. In case any candidate does not fulfill the benchmarks of eligibility as per the guidelines of the concerned Regulatory Authority, his/her admission shall be cancelled on his/her risk and responsibility under intimation to the Board at the earliest so that the same seat shall be filled up in subsequent round of counseling.
