He highlighted that commemorative coins with denominations such as Rs 25, Rs 50, Rs 60, Rs 75, Rs 90, Rs 100, Rs 125, Rs 150, Rs 175, Rs 200, Rs 250, Rs 350, Rs 400, Rs 500, Rs 525, Rs 550, and Rs 1000, which were not meant for circulation, are also on display.

The exhibition will continue to offer the public a chance to explore this rich collection until 8th September during 11 AM to 5PM serving as an educational and cultural platform for all visitors.
