## CS reviews HADP projects, calls for corrective measures

SRINAGAR: Chief Secretary, Atal Dulloo on Friday chaired a meeting at Civil Secretariat here to review the status and progress of implementation of projects under Holistic Agriculture Development Program (HADP). Besides, Principal Secretary Agriculture Production Department, the meeting was attended by Managing Director & CEO, J&K Bank, Mission Director, HADP, All Deputy Commissioners of J&K UT, heads of various departments. Assessing the performance of each project on different parameters, Chief Secretary emphasized the need to expedite establishment of various project activities. During the meeting, key issues were identified with immediate directives issued for their resolution. Dulloo said that there must be focused attention on the extension and outreach of HADP activities to ensure that intending beneficiaries across the length and breadth of J&K are brought within the ambit of HADP. He called

for a thorough analytical study of the implementation process so far to identify the areas where we are lacking. He said that the study will help us in identifying the gaps so that tailor made corrective measures are taken to fill those gaps. He impressed upon the officers to commit themselves towards achieving the set targets within stipulated timelines, ensuring optimal utilization of allocated resources. He asked them to expedite ongoing works on these prestigious projects so that benefits are provided to the farming community. Chief Secretary further called for coordinated efforts between farmers, APD, universities, HoDs for smooth flow of the implementation process. During the meeting, the officers presented detailed updates on implementation status, challenges encountered and strategies to expedite pending activities under these schemes. The review concluded with a reaffirmed commitment to expedite project activities and ensure effective collaboration among all stakeholders to achieve the objectives of the HADP.

## RC reviews preparations for Kashmiri Migrants' participation in Assembly elections

NEW DELHI: Relief & Rehabilitation Commissioner (M), J&K, Dr. Arvind Karwani on Friday chaired a meeting with the Assistant Returning Officers and representatives of the prominent Kashmiri Migrant organizations at New-Delhi, to take stock of the arrangements being put in place with regard to conduct of upcoming General Elections to Legislative Assembly.

Dr Karwani emphasized on ensuring all requisite Assured Minimum Facilities (AMF) at all designated Special Polling Stations at New-Delhi viz. permanent ramps, drinking water, toilet facilities as per norms of Election Commission of India. He emphasized on reaching out to the voters and ensuring all necessary facility, particularly keeping in view the scattered population of the migrants in the Delhi NCT region. Pertinent to mention that

the Election Commission of India Vide Notification No-3/J&K-LA/2024 dated 22-08-2024, has notified the scheme for Kashmiri Migrants to vote in person at notified Special Polling Stations and voting by means of postal ballots pertaining to the General Election to Assembly Constituencies falling in Kashmir Province of the UT of Jammu and Kashmir. As per the notified scheme 19 Special Polling Stations in Jammu and 01 in Udhampur have been mapped to the Camps/Zones individually,

ensuring that every Zone has at least one special polling station. The intra-zonal jurisdiction for each such polling station has been earmarked keeping in mind the distance/ease of approach for each set of electors. All electors within 07 days of the notification of the draft electoral roll extract, can approach the respective Assistant Returning Officers (Migrant) at Jammu and Udhampur, or their respective Zonal Officers (Nodal Officers)/Booth Level Officers (BLO's), in case

his/her name does not figure in the draft electoral roll extract, or in case any elector wishes to opt for voting through postal ballot or vote at original polling station in Kashmir valley. Further, Deputy Director Horticulture (P&M) and Deputy Secretary in the Office of Resident Commissioner, have also been appointed as the ARO for the receipt of applications, conduct of poll etc at the special polling stations provided in Delhi. Four special polling stations have been set up at New-Delhi. The require-

ment of filing M-Form in Delhi has also been simplified. Any 'notified voter' who wishes to vote by post is required to make an application for postal ballot in Form 12-C appended to the Conduct of Election Rules, 1961 to any of the AROs at least 10 days before the date of poll in the in the Assembly constituency in which he is registered as elector. The ARO Migrant at Jammu has been made solely responsible for handling these applications. The Form -12 C and M-form (for migrants residing outside J&K) can also be sent through online mode through concerned ERO where the migrant is residing. Dr Karwani, appreciated the suggestions put forth by the representatives of prominent social organizations, regarding facilitation of migrant voters, and asked the concerned Assistant Returning Officers to involve them in SVEEP activities.

## DB impleads CBI as party in Arm Licensed scam

JAMMU: In a significant order, a Division Bench of High Court of J&K and Ladakh at Jammu comprising Chief Justice (Acting) Tashi Rabstan and Justice Puneet Gupta impleaded Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) as a Party Respondent in the much publicised Public Interest Litigation (PIL No. 9/2012) titled Sheikh Mohd Shafi and Anr V/s Union of India and Ors, and issued notice to the CBI through its Director, New Delhi and Superintendent of Police/Head of Branch, CBI, Special Crime Branch, Sector 38-A, Chandigarh returnable by or before

October 15th, 2024. When this PIL came up for hearing, Advocate Sheikh Shakeel Ahmed with Advocate Rahul Raina appearing for the PIL submitted that despite last and final opportunity granted to the Union of India and UT Administration of J&K, no response has been filed to the application (CM No. 7441/2023) filed by the petitioners seeking impleadment of CBI as party respondent in the aforementioned PIL. Advocate S.S. Ahmed further submitted that on the request of J&K Government, the CBI has registered two FIRs in the infamous Arms Licences Scam wherein several IAS/JKAS Officers are

allegedly involved and in this regard CBI at Chandigarh has registered two FIRs i.e. RCCHG051201850006 and RCCHG051201850007. Advocate S.S. Ahmed further submitted that the period of scam which is under investigation relates back to 2012-2016 and CBI is at the advanced stage of investigation and for monitoring of the investigation, the status report is required to be summoned from CBI, Chandigarh Branch, so that a view is taken by the Division Bench in a matter of wide public importance relating to National Security. After considering the submissions of Advocate S. S.

Ahmed, the Division Bench headed by Chief Justice (Acting) Tashi Rabstan allowed the application (CM No. 7441/2023) and impleaded CBI as party respondent in the PIL. At this stage, Advocate S.S. Ahmed further submitted that DSGI Vishal Sharma appearing for Union of India has filed a latest Status Affidavit dated September 3rd, 2024 in compliance to the directions of the Division Bench dated August 13th, 2024 wherein there is a reference of 03 IAS Officers allegedly involved in the Arms Licences Scam. Since, the said Status Affidavit had not been scanned by the Registry, the Division Bench orally directed the Registry to scan the same so that the same may be considered on the next date of hearing. Advocate S.S. Ahmed vociferously argued that despite categoric directions to Senior AAG S. S Nanda to file updated Status Report with regard to the current status of prosecution sanction in respect of two IAS Officers, the needful has not been done and the Division Bench on August 13th, 2024 had granted last and final opportunity to the GAD to do the needful but there is complete non-serious attitude of the GAD and no respect is shown to the Court orders in a case involving National Security. At this stage Senior AAG S.S. Nanda appearing for GAD sought further time to do the needful in terms of order dated August 13th, 2024 and the Division Bench reluctantly allowed the prayer of Senior AAG S.S. Nanda. Advocate Ahtsham Bhat appeared for FCI in the matter.

## Land proposed for allotment to ex-servicemen Zanskar is not encroached: HC directs UT ladakh

JAMMU: Justice Rajnesh Oswal of Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh High Court directed UT of Ladakh to ensure that the land proposed for allotment to the ex-servicemen Zanskar, District Kargil is not encroached upon by anyone and in the event the said land has been encroached by anyone the respondents shall proceed against the encroacher(s) in accordance with law. This order has been passed in a petition filed by Ex Servicemen Union Zanskar District Kargil UT Ladakh through its president Tsering Wangdun seeking direction to the respondents to issue formal allotment order of the proposed land reserved for ex-servicemen of Zanskar, District Kargil, with further prayer to remove the encroachment

from the land proposed for the ex-servicemen. Objections have been filed by the respondents wherein it is contended that disputed questions of fact have been raised by the petitioner which cannot be considered while adjudicating the writ petition. It is further averred that the land measuring 1175 kanals and 11 marlas was proposed for allotment to the ex-servicemen of Zanskar Tehsil vide letter dated July 28, 1986 and out of this land 192 kanals of land has already been allotted to 48 families of ex-servicemen in the ratio of 4 kanals per head vide Deputy Commissioner, Kargil's order dated November 10, 2000 and it is further stated that notice has been issued to the encroacher. Justice Rajnesh Oswal

observed that the prayer of the petitioner for allotment of the land proposed for allotment to ex-servicemen of Zanskar district Kargil cannot be acceded to as it is for the respondents to allot the land to the eligible ex-servicemen. However, no one can encroach upon the government land and in the event any such land is encroached upon, the respondents can evict the encroacher in accordance with law. Justice Rajnesh Oswal while disposing of the petition, directed respondents to issue formal allotment order of the proposed land reserved for ex-servicemen of Zanskar, District Kargil, with further prayer to remove the encroachment from the land proposed for the ex-servicemen.
