NDA nominee C P Radhakrishnan defeats Oppn's Reddy; elected Vice President of India

NEW DELHI: NDA candidate CP Radhakrishnan won the vice presidential election on Tuesday by bagging 452 votes, while opposition candidate B Sudershan Reddy polled 300 votes, Returning Officer P C Mody said.

The vote tally suggested some cross-voting in favour of Radhakrishnan. BJP leaders claimed that at least 15 opposition members voted for the NDA nominee. Earlier, the Congress had claimed that the opposition stood united with all of its 315 MPs turning up to vote in the vice presidential polls. A total of 767 MPs cast their ballot in a turnout of 98.2 per cent, of which 752
