Audit report can't be gospel: HC tears into FCI's arbitrary action

JAMMU: Coming down heavily on the Food Corporation of India (FCI), the High Court of Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh has quashed recovery proceedings initiated against several Jammu-based flour mills, holding the action to be arbitrary, unlawful, and violative of fundamental rights.

Justice Wasim Sadiq Nargal, while delivering a common judgment in petitions, ruled that the Comptroller and Auditor General of India (CAG) has no jurisdiction to determine the quality of wheat lifted under government tenders, stressing that such technical matters fall exclusively within

the domain of FCI's own officers and quality control agencies. The petitioners-Mahajan Roller Flour Mills and Amar Group of Mills-challenged FCI's demand of over Rs 2.7 lakh on the allegation that they had lifted FAQ (Fair Average Quality) wheat instead of URS (Under Relaxed Specification) wheat in 2015-16. The Court observed that the entire stock had been certified and released by FCI's staff at the time of delivery, leaving no scope to penalize the millers years later. Any fault, it added, lay with FCI officials themselves.

The High Court slammed FCI for relying solely on a CAG audit remark without supplying its copy to the peti-

tioners or granting them a fair hearing. "Audit reports cannot be treated as binding adjudications," the judgment said, adding that unilateral action based on such remarks offends Articles 14 and 21 of the Constitution.

The Court also highlighted the five-year delay in raising recovery claims, ruling the proceedings barred by limitation and laches. Quashing the impugned orders, it restrained FCI from withholding any payments or creating obstacles in the petitioners' future tenders.

The ruling delivers a stern message that CAG reports are recommendatory, not gospel truth, and cannot be weaponized to impose penalties without proper inquiry and judicial oversight.

HC dismisses promotion plea of Ex-SRTC officer found guilty of embezzlement

JAMMU: The High Court of Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh has dismissed an appeal filed by a retired officer of the J&K State Road Transport Corporation (SRTC), who sought retrospective promotions despite proven charges of embezzlement, ruling that his claim was "bereft of merit."

The judgment in LPA was delivered by a division bench comprising Justice Sindhu Sharma and Justice Shahzad Azeem. The appellant, Syed Muzaffar Hussain (76), a retired Depot Manager, was represented by senior advocate Z.A. Qurashi with advocate Anurag Verma. The respondents were represented by senior advocate Altaf Haqani with advocate Asif Wani for SRTC, and Rahella Khan as assisting counsel for the Accountant General.

Hussain retired in 2004, but during service was found guilty of embezzling over Rs 5.33 lakh of Corporation revenue. On a mercy plea, SRTC treated part of his suspension period as duty purely on humanitarian grounds, so that his pensionary benefits would not be adversely affected. This arrangement, accepted by both parties in a 2008 writ petition, limited his entitlement only to post-retiral monetary benefits.

Despite this, Hussain continued litigating for nearly two decades, claiming that the words "consequential benefits" in earlier court orders entitled him to promotions up to Traffic Manager and Deputy Manager. The bench held that the appellant had been consistently trying to "probate and reprobate" by twisting the meaning of consequential benefits. The Court made it clear that in his case, the phrase referred only to pensionary adjustments flowing from the 2008 committee recommendations,

not promotions. It further observed that the contempt court orders cited by Hussain had wrongly widened the scope of the original writ order. Citing the Supreme Court's ruling in Sudhir Vasudeva v. M. George Ravishekeran (2014), the bench emphasized that courts, while dealing with contempt jurisdiction, cannot travel beyond the four corners of the original judgment.

The Division Bench also noted that Hussain never sought promotion in his original petition; his relief was confined to settlement of suspension periods and pensionary benefits. "This is a classic case where the appellant has tried to take undue advantage of an erroneous interpretation," the bench said, holding that he is stopped from claiming anything beyond post-retiral dues.

Finding no error in the single judge's order of May 18, 2023, the Division Bench dismissed the appeal, vacating all interim directions. Hussain will only be entitled to the monetary benefits already settled, bringing to an end his prolonged legal battle.
