Whereas you had applied for Maternity leave w.e.f 27.07.2024 to 22.01.2025 for 180 days vide No. DHJ/1951-54 dated 06.12.2024.

Whereas after availing the Maternity leave, you joined the department only for one day on 23.01.2025. After that you applied for Child Care Leave w.e.f 24.01.2025 to 24.03.2025. The sanctioning authority sanctioned CCL vide Leave order No. DHJ/555-60 dated 26.03.2025 for 60 (sixty days).

Whereas you sent an application through e-Mail in the official mail that you are resigning from service after availing Child Care Leave dated 27.03.2025 and on 02.04.2025, you sent another Mail requesting for cancellations of your resignation and submitted that you are with your family in Diamapur (Nagaland) with the request that you need time of 20 days so that you can join office without any fail.

Whereas from 25.03.2025 to 21.04.2025 you were on unauthorized leave without prior information and permission. After that you joined the office only for four days w.e.f 22.04.2025 to 25.04.2025 & after that from 26.04.2025 to till date you are absent from duty without any information and prior permission from the office.

Whereas Three explanations have been called vide No. DHJ/775-78 dated 01.05.2025, Letter No. DHJ/956-58 dated 28.05.2025 and vide Letter No. DHJ/1176-80 dated 04.07.2025, you have not submitted any reply nor joined the duty till date.

However, you are once again directed to resume your duties within a period of 07 days from the date of issuance of this notice, failing which the action for your termination from Government service shall be initiated in terms of Article 128 of J&K CSRs Vol. I.
