The procedure was carried out successfully at SMVDNSH, and the patient is recovering well under regular follow-up. This marks the fourth such advanced procedure performed at the hospital within the past year, with all patients showing excellent outcomes

ing case due to the heavy calcification in the patient's arteries With IVL technology, we could safely prepare the vessels and implant stents with success. IVL is one of the most advanced
