The Centre will serve as a hub for advancing interdisciplinary research, preserving regional dialects, promoting emotional intelligence, and

showcasing the cultural heritage of the Union Territory.

Guidelines for the "Earn While Learn Scheme" for the benefit of all University students, aimed at supporting them financially while providing practical exposure and skill development was also endorsed by the Syndicate.

The commencement of a two-year M.A. (History) programme in the Centre for Distance and Online Education (CDOE) from the academic session 2026-27 was also endorsed.
