

# Dr. Shyama Prasad Mookherjee Smriti Nyas hosts intellectual meet on Next-Gen GST Reforms

JAMMU: Dr. Shyama Prasad Mookherjee Smriti Nyas organized a thought-provoking Intellectual Meet on "Next-Gen GST Reforms" at Hotel Asia, Jammu.

The event, held from 3:30 PM to 6:00 PM, brought together experts, officials, and policy-makers to discuss the transformative impact of the recent GST rate revisions announced in the 56th GST Council Meeting on 3rd September 2025.

Presided over by Sat Sharma,

the meet featured CA Aanchal Kapoor as the Key Speaker. Guests of Honour included Umair Meer (Addl. Commissioner, CGST), Afaq Ahmed Giri (Joint Commissioner, CGST), and Manoj Prabhakar (Joint Controller, Legal Metrology, Jammu). Prominent attendees included MLA Yudhvir Sethi, and Priya Sethi, among others.

In his address, Sat Sharma hailed the reforms as a historic shift toward a simplified two-rate GST structure-5% and 18%-which he said would inject

Rs 2 lakh crore into the economy. He lauded PM Modi's pro-people economic vision, noting that 99% of goods in the 12% bracket and 90% in the 28% bracket would now benefit from rate cuts.

CA Aanchal Kapoor detailed the changes, including tax exemptions on essentials like milk, curd, and paneer; and significant reductions on daily-use items and agricultural inputs. She emphasized how simplified compliance, enhanced refunds, and MSME incentives would boost consumption and busi-

ness confidence.

Umair Meer discussed AI-driven audit simplifications and auto-registration benefits for small businesses. Afaq Ahmed Giri highlighted tax relief on essentials and consumer goods, promoting a consumption-driven economy. Manoj Prabhakar addressed benefits for the agriculture sector, including reduced GST on fertilizers and farming equipment.

All officials urged traders to pass on GST benefits to consumers and warned of legal action for non-compliance.

Conducted by CA Deepak Kapahi, the event was praised for facilitating meaningful dialogue. The meet underscored the success of cooperative federalism in implementing reforms and reflected on how these changes position India as a global economic leader.
