

Sat assures flood-hit people of relief and rehabilitation, slams NC govt's neglect of Jammu region

JAMMU: Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) Jammu & Kashmir President and former minister Sat Sharma (CA) conducted an extensive visit to flood-affected areas of Suchetgarh and Bishnah assembly constituencies, reaffirming the party's unwavering commitment to stand by the distressed people and ensure their rehabilitation.

During his visit to Village Chak Hanso in Suchetgarh, Sat Sharma, accompanied by MLA Gharu Ram Bhagat, former Minister Sham Choudhary, and District President Rinku Choudhary, interacted with the affected families and listened to their grievances.

Later, he also visited Indira Nagar Colony Panchayat Kharian in Bishnah along with MLA Rajiv Bhagat, former MLC Charanjit Singh Khaksa, District Prabhari Rajinder Singh Chib, and District President Rinku



Choudhary. Sat Sharma said that Prime Minister Narendra Modi has always shown equal concern for every part of Jammu & Kashmir, irrespective of region or community. "The Union Government under PM Modi is committed to provide maximum relief to the affected people and ensure long-term measures of rehabilitation. We want to assure the people that their suffering is our concern,

and BJP will continue its service until normalcy returns," he stated. He, however, expressed disappointment at the "casual and discriminatory" approach of the ruling NC government, which has failed to address the urgent needs of the people in the Jammu region. This neglect has only added to the misery of flood-affected families, he said.

Sat Sharma highlighted

that BJP representatives and cadres have been consistently serving the affected families by providing essential help, food packets, and facilitating government relief measures. He reaffirmed that the party will continue to work with full dedication to mitigate the suffering of the people, reflecting the Modi Government's philosophy of Sabka Saath, Sabka Vikas, Sabka Vishwas.

Gharu Ram Bhagat expressed gratitude to the Union Government for its swift support and assured that he and his colleagues would remain in constant touch with the people of Suchetgarh to ensure their rehabilitation.

NC's frustration behind National Emblem disrespect: Vibodh

JAMMU: Holding the NC directly responsible for the shameful act of disrespect against the revered National Emblem of India, Senior BJP leader and former MLC Vibodh Gupta said that such frustrated attempts are being carried out intentionally to disturb peace in Jammu & Kashmir. Expressing deep anguish, he declared that those who dare to dishonour the National Emblem insult every citizen of this country and weaken the foundation of our democracy. He maintained that such reckless and outrageous acts must be met with the strictest legal punishment so that no one ever dares to repeat them.

Vibodh urged the people of India to rise above divisions and safeguard the sanctity of this sacred symbol. He said

that the dignity of India is non-negotiable and the National Emblem reminds us of our unbreakable spirit - it is the thread that binds 1.4 billion hearts together. Any attack on it is an attack on Bharat itself.
